This Weeks's Pursuit: Crystallization Study of Leviticus, Week 03

The Continual Burnt Offering— a Living Sacrifice

Scripture Reading: Lev. 1:3-4, 8-9; 6:9, 12a, 13; Heb. 12:29; Rom. 12:1

In this universe there is such a One who lived a life absolutely for God... Christ came to do the will of the Father; He came in the Father's name and not in His own name. He did nothing from Himself, and He spoke not His own words but as His Father taught Him... He was God incarnate; He lived absolutely for God, and He offered Himself to God as the burnt offering, without blemish or spot. While everyone else is for himself, God made the provision to have Christ as the spotless Lamb as our burnt offering that we may lay our hands on Him and be identified with Him.

From the time we were born we are taught to develop **ourselves**, live for **ourselves**, do things by **ourselves**, and take care of our **ourselves**. By default we live for **ourselves** and to **ourselves**. We were meant to live for God and be absolutely for God, but we live for **ourselves**. Therefore, Christ came as the reality of the **burnt offering**, fulfilling the type of this offering through His living on earth. He lived a perfect human life, and He did everything from God, to God, and for God's glory. His words were God's words, His actions were God's actions, and He took the Father as the source and goal of everything He said and did.

The Divine Trinity seen in the Type of the Burnt Offering

The entire Divine Trinity is revealed in the type of the burnt offering – Christ the Son is the burnt offering, the tent of meeting, and the offerer; Jehovah as the Receiver and the fire is actually God the Father; and the water washing the inward parts is a type of the Spirit. The entire Divine Trinity works together and coordinates together to make a way for us to enter into God, experience God, and be absolutely for God.

Then our **service** will be out of God, not out of ourselves, but a sweet fragrance of Christ.

The Need for Continual Burnt Offering

Today in our Christian life and in our church life there's a need for the continual burnt offering, that is, there's the need for a continual consecration, a continual offering ourselves to the Lord. The burnt offering is so significant and wonderful: the entire Divine Trinity is involved in the aspects of this offering, and Christ Himself is the burnt offering; all the details of the burnt offering are so rich in meaning, but what is the application of this offering to our experience in the church and the Christian life?

According to the law of the burnt offering, this offering had to be offered continually on the altar, day and night, and the priests had to add wood on the fire day and night... In the application of the burnt offering to our experience, although we cannot say that the burnt offering is our consecration, we can say that it is intimately related to our consecration. Our consecration is intimately related to the experience of the burnt offering.

Never say that you consecrated when you first got saved – **that's too long ago**. Don't say you consecrated last month or last year. Every day there has to be a fresh application of our consecration. We need to live a life of a continual burnt offering, and our consecration should not be only so often but continual. Whether we are up or down, victorious or defeated, we need to consecrate ourselves to the Lord. Whether we feel like it or not, our burnt offering has to be continual. Our consecration is not an activity that we do from time to time, when we are up in our Christian life, but a living, a life. We need to live a life of continual consecration, a life of continual burnt offering for God's satisfaction, in our Christian life and church life.

The daily burnt offering in the Old Testament typifies that we in the New Testament who belong to God should offer ourselves daily to God (Num. 28:3-8). We need to daily offer ourselves to God, renewing our consecration to Him in the morning and in the evening, determining not to do anything but turning our life over to Him. It is good to tell the Lord early in the morning and late in the evening, "Lord, thank You for this day: I offer myself to You, and I take You as my burnt offering. I am just an unprofitable slave – I do all I can, but I take You as my burnt offering, for You are the One who is absolute for God and wholly for His satisfaction. When God sees our consecration, He appreciates our being a living sacrifice, and He is satisfied."

- 5. Lord, we present ourselves as **living** sacrifice to God. Although we are many, there is only one sacrifice and one service offered in the one Body of Christ. Thank You Lord that as we offer ourselves to You continually, You can also use us continually.

LIFE STUDY OF COLOSSIANS

"One Life-Study a Day Makes One Holy"

Presenting Every Man Full-Grown in Christ

July 16, 2018, Monday (Message 16)

Even in preaching the gospel, our aim should be to impart life in order to present others mature, full-grown, in Christ. As we preach the gospel to unbelievers, minister Christ to them, and help them to receive the Lord, our goal is not merely that they should be saved from the lake of fire and from God's condemnation. Our goal is not only for them to experience God's forgiveness; it is to minister Christ into them so that they may eventually be presented full-grown in Christ. If we fail to impart Christ to others as we preach the gospel, our gospel preaching will fall short of God's standard. Christ must be infused into all those to whom we speak. Imparting Christ should be our aim in our gospel preaching. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 16, section 1)

Struggling According to the Operation of Christ

July 17, 2018, Tuesday (Message 17)

Only after their hearts had been comforted could the Colossians receive the revelation concerning Christ. Because this matter is so important, this book emphasizes the heart instead of the spirit. We cannot present others full-grown in Christ unless their hearts have been comforted. If their hearts have not been cherished, they will not be able to receive anything we minister to them concerning Christ. Therefore, the first step in presenting others full-grown in Christ is to comfort their hearts unto all the riches of the full assurance of understanding. Especially the leading ones should look to the Lord for the grace to be able to comfort all the distracted, dissatisfied, and disappointed hearts. When the hearts of the saints have been comforted, it will be easy for us to minister the riches of Christ to them. But if the saints have problems in their hearts, they will have trouble with their minds. The only way to solve the problems in the mind is for the hearts to be adjusted through the Lord's cherishing. This is a crucial lesson for us all to learn. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 17, section 3)

Christ—the Mystery of God

July 18, 2018, Wednesday (Message 18)

God Himself is a mystery, and Christ is the mystery of this mystery. Surely we cannot fathom such a mystery simply by reading the letter of the Scriptures. Since Christ dwells in our spirit, we need to exercise our spirit in order to know Him as the mystery of God. Never regard Christ as a mere object to be known in an outward way. As the crucified and resurrected One, He is living both on the throne in the heavens and in our spirit as well. Hence, it is of utmost importance that we exercise our spirit to contact Him. This means that we must open up from the depths of our being and call on Him. Our spirit is our deepest part, deeper than the heart and all the parts of the soul. Therefore, to exercise our spirit is to open the deepest part of our being to call on the name of the Lord Jesus and to contact Him as the living One within us. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 17, section 1)

The Experience of Christ as the Mystery of God July 19, 2018, Thursday (Message 19)

If we would experience Christ as the mystery of God, we need to have the full knowledge of Him as God's mystery. We have pointed out that Paul struggled for the Colossians that their hearts would be comforted "unto the full knowledge of the mystery of God, Christ". In order to have the full knowledge of such a mystery, our whole being needs to be exercised. If we simply believe in Christ without loving Him, we cannot have this knowledge. Likewise, if we love Him partially but not wholly, we cannot have the full knowledge of Him. We need to love the Lord Jesus with our whole being. For this reason, Mark 12:30, quoting Deuteronomy 6:5, says, "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength." When our entire being is exercised to love the Lord Jesus, we shall gain the full knowledge of Him. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 19, section 1)

To Walk in Christ, the Mystery of God July 20, 2018, Friday (Message 20)

Having the full assurance that the all-inclusive Spirit is mingled with our spirit, we should set our minds on this mingled spirit. By doing this, we are spontaneously setting our minds on Christ. Then we must go on to walk in this mingled spirit. This means that we must live, move, behave, and have our being according to the spirit. In this way we shall experience Christ and enjoy Him as the good land. Nothing in the New Testament is more central, crucial, and vital than walking according to the mingled spirit. Christ as the all-inclusive Spirit dwells in our spirit to be our life, our person, and our everything. Our need today is to return to Him, to set our minds on the spirit, and to walk according to the spirit. This is to walk in Christ as the mystery of God. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 20, section 3)
