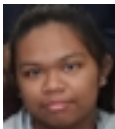

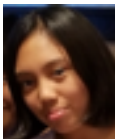

Him. There is no peace on earth except the churches.



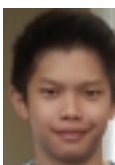

LIFE STUDY OF COLOSSIANS

"One Life-Study a Day Makes One Holy"

Walk in Christ, Having Been Rooted and Being Built Up in Him

August 27, 2018, Monday (Message 46)

Our living should not be according to anything other than Christ. The most subtle substitutes of Christ are the various elements of our culture. Now Christ must come in to replace all these substitutes with Himself. If this is our experience, we shall not have anything other than Christ in our daily living. **We shall live, move, act, and have our being in Christ. For this, there are two conditions: being rooted in Christ and being built up in Christ to become the expression of Christ.** The expression of Christ, Christ lived out of us, will eventually become corporate. This is the church as the Body and the new man. When the church becomes in reality such a new man, that will be the time for Christ to come back. May the Lord have mercy on us and grant us His grace that we may live Him in the church in this way. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 46, section 4)

Rooted and Built Up in Christ with the Processed God

August 28, 2018, Tuesday (Message 47)

We need to continually exercise our spirit. This is the reason that toward the end of the book of Colossians, Paul charges us to persevere in prayer. However, if, instead of exercising our spirit, we exercise our mind, emotion, and will, Satan will keep us from enjoying the all-inclusive Spirit in our spirit. Satan, the subtle, evil one, uses the environment to keep us out of the spirit. Thus, **we need to exercise our spirit continually by calling on the name of the Lord in order to become more deeply rooted into the all-inclusive Spirit.** Then we shall absorb the riches of Christ, grow in Christ, and spontaneously be built up in Christ. As a result, we shall walk in Him. If we understand this, we shall know what it means to walk in Christ by absorbing His riches and by being built up with what we have absorbed. This is the practical experience of Christ we all need. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 47, section 3)

The Receiving of Christ

August 29, 2018, Wednesday (Message 48)

Receiving Christ requires the exercise of our spirit. In order for a transistor radio to receive radio waves, the receiver must be working properly. Likewise, although it is good to improve our behavior, **the important thing is that we tune, or adjust, our spirit. Our spirit must be clean, open, and properly adjusted.** The Christ we have received is God with His wonderful history. As the all-inclusive One, Christ includes divinity, humanity, human living, crucifixion, resurrection, ascension, glorification, and enthronement. **He includes all the divine attributes and human virtues. This is the One we have all received.** (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 48, sections 2,3)

Full Grown in Christ

August 30, 2018, Thursday (Message 49)

To be full grown in Christ is to be filled and saturated with Christ. We remain ourselves, but we are permeated, saturated, and filled with Christ. Then our living spontaneously is Christ. **We should not simply say, "Christ lives in me." We must be absolute with the Lord to allow Him to live in us day by day.** If your husband or wife gives you a difficult time, do not defend yourself or vindicate yourself. Simply let Christ live in you. However, we must admit that it is easy to talk about this, but it is difficult to practice it. The proper Christian life is not a matter of ethics, morality, or improved character or behavior. The Christian life is Christ living in us. **We should live according to Christ, not according to our natural mildness, humility, or frankness.** We need to live Christ. Christ must saturate us, permeate us, and fill us. Then in our living He will be expressed from within us. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 49, section 3)

Christ Replaced in Every Way

August 31, 2018, Friday (Message 50)

If we have light concerning how Christ is replaced in our daily living, we shall confess to the Lord that instead of living Him we live so many other things. We may say to Him, *"Lord, I confess that I have not lived very much by You. I live a clean life, even a pure life, but I do not live Christ. Although I have been careful not to sin and not to be wrong with others, I have not lived You."* Years ago, I spent much time to confess my failures and wrongdoings; however, at that time I did not confess my lack in living Christ. But recently most of my confession has concerned one thing—my shortage in living Christ. **We all need to make such a confession to the Lord.** (Excerpt from the Life-Study of Colossians, chapter 50, section 3)
