Enjoying Christ as the Reality of the Peace Offering at the Lord's Table to Present the Total Picture of God's Economy

Scripture Reading: Lev. 3:1-17; 7:11-38

The enjoyment of Christ as our peace, especially at the **Lord's Table**, should be **kept from** all **uncleanness** and **death**, and we all should enjoy Christ in His **love** and **strength**. When we come to the Lord's Table meeting we should **prove** ourselves and **discern** the Table, not coming to eat the Lord as our peace in an **unclean** way but **cleansing** ourselves and **staying away** from **death** and **uncleanness**... Our God is **training** us, His people, to live a **holy, clean**, and **rejoicing life**, and for this He **provides** us with Christ as the reality of all the offerings to be our all-inclusive provision. We need to enjoy Christ as the reality of the peace offering at the Lord's Table to present the total picture of God's economy. When we come together **at the Lord's table**, we need to **leave** all other places – leave our **flesh**, our **self**, our **natural man**, our **mind**, our **emotion**, and our **will** – and **come** to the place which God has chosen, our **mingled spirit**, where we can offer God the worship that He desires.

God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship on spirit and truthfulness.

We need to be in our mingled spirit on the Lord's Day as we gather to eat the Lord's supper, and we need to offer Christ to God for His satisfaction; we need to offer the Christ which has been **wrought** into our being through our experience of Him as the reality of all the offerings. God desires to have only Christ, for only Christ satisfies God and brings pleasure to Him. We need to daily **enjoy** Christ, **participate** in Christ, and **experience** Christ, and we need to **bring** the top portion of Christ to the Lord's Table meeting to offer to God for His satisfaction.

We need to **be saved** from any kind of **hypocritical routine** at the Lord's Table, and have Christ as our **genuineness** and **truthfulness**. The Lord's Table is the only meeting that the Lord Himself **initiated** and **commanded** us to eat and partake of it until He comes. It is what He wants us to do **until He returns**, for the Lord's

Table is a **bridge** between His first and His second coming. From His first to His second coming, all we do as believers is **eat** the Lord, **drink** Him, **experience** Him, and **bring** Him to the Father for His satisfaction.

Here at the Lord's Table we enjoy Christ as our peace offering, and here we see a complete picture of **God's economy** in the elements on the table and the spiritual reality they represent. If we read Leviticus 1:1 – 6:7 we see that the sequence of the five offerings is according to our practical experience, while the sequence in 6:8-7:38 is according to the total picture of God's economy.

If we are unveiled to see what God's economy is, we will realize that the five main offerings and our enjoyment of the peace offering as the issuing offering is for us to present the total picture of God's economy at the Lord's table. The peace offering **signifies** Christ as our peace with God that we may **enjoy** Christ **with** God and **with** man in **fellowship** and **joy**, and it is primarily **fulfilled** in our **enjoying** Christ at the **Lord's table** in the breaking of bread **for the remembrance of Him** and in the **offering** of Christ to the Father **for the worship of the Father**.

Burnt Offering as the Base for Sin Offering and the Meal Offering as the Qualification for the Trespass Offering

God wants us to enjoy His economy around His Son, Jesus Christ; He is our burnt offering, our meal offering, our sin offering, and our trespass offering so that we may enjoy Him as our peace. When we take Christ **as** our **burnt offering**, laying our hands on Him and taking Him **as** our **absoluteness**, we offer Him **as** our **sin offering**, for by nature we are not what He wants us to be. Then, we **eat** Christ **as** our **meal offering**, we are nourished with Him, and we confess any sins that His light exposes in our being. The result is that we have peace with God and with man, and we offer Christ **as** our **peace offering** to God for His satisfaction, especially at the Lord's table meeting. This is to experience Christ as our peace offering according to the total picture of God's economy. (Excerpt from the Ministry of the Word, Crystallization-study of Leviticus).

LIFE STUDY OF COLOSSIANS

"One Life-Study a Day Makes One Holy"

One with Christ in the Things Above

September 17, 2018, Monday (Message 61)

We all need to be—one with Christ in His heavenly ministry. **We all need to keep ourselves one with Christ in the things above.** We should not be distracted by ethical admonitions of any sort. All such admonitions are elements of the world. We should be concerned only with Christ and His ministry in heaven. The Christ who is seated in heaven is working, interceding, and ministering. Let us be one with Him in these things. This is to be one with Christ in the things above. **Whenever we are one with Him in the things above, we experience a divine transfusion.** Then we are brought into God, and God is brought into us. This comes from the interceding and ministering of the all-inclusive Christ. (Except from the Life-Studies of Colossians chapter 61, section 4)

The Renewing of the New Man

September 18, 2018, Tuesday (Message 62)

This principle of growing unto knowledge applies to our spiritual life. If we seek the things on earth instead of the things above, we shall not have the renewing of the new man. This means that we shall not experience the growth of the new man. It is extremely difficult for the new man to grow as long as we seek earthly things. But **when we seek the things above, the new man grows within us. The result of this growth is full knowledge.** Therefore, the new man grows unto full knowledge. Years ago, the new man within you had not grown very much. This made it difficult for you to know spiritual things. But now that the new man has grown within you, it is much easier for you to understand spiritual things. **This indicates that growth issues in knowledge.** This is the reason Paul says that the new man is being renewed unto full knowledge. (Except from the Life-Studies of Colossians chapter 62, section 3)

The Peace of Christ Arbitrating in Our Heart

September 19, 2018, Wednesday (Message 63)

The church life as the life of the new man is preserved not by mere teachings, but **by setting our mind on the things above and allowing the heavenly transmission to impart the divine element into us.** Then we shall have the renewing of the new man and experience the peace of Christ ruling within us. **The peace of Christ is actually Christ Himself** in a particular aspect. **Hence, the arbitrating of the peace of Christ is Christ working within us to exercise His rule over us, to speak the last word, and to make the final decision.** In the case of the brother offended by the elder, Christ's word is to love that elder, to seek him out for fellowship, and to enjoy the Lord with him. This is Christ enthroned as peace ruling, deciding, and uttering the last word. (Except from the Life-Studies of Colossians chapter 63, section 3)

The Word of Christ Inhabiting Us

September 20, 2018, Thursday (Message 64)

We thank the Lord that the situation in His recovery is altogether different from this. **We have an abundance of the Lord's speaking.** Consider how much of **the word of God has been released among us** in the recovery during the past years. The reason there is so much of God's speaking in the recovery is that here we have genuine oneness. **We experience this oneness and the harmony** in the Spirit not only when the churches come together for a conference, but also **in the meetings of the various local churches. In the meetings we have the Lord's speaking, and we are edified, nourished, and enlightened.** When the peace of Christ arbitrates in us and keeps us in a situation full of oneness and harmony, **we become the place of God's speaking, His oracle.** Deep in my spirit I realize that the meetings are an oracle, a place where God can come in to speak. (Except from the Life-Studies of Colossians chapter 64, section 2)

Persevering in Prayer

September 21, 2018, Friday (Message 65)

In order to **fight on God's side** against Satan, **we need to persevere in prayer. To persevere in prayer is to continue persistently, steadfastly, and earnestly.** This perseverance is needed because the course of the whole world is away from God. **To pray is to go against the current, the trend, in the fallen universe.** Persevering in prayer is like rowing a boat upstream. If you do not persevere, you will be carried downstream by the current. No doubt, to persevere in this way, either in rowing or in praying, requires a great deal of energy. The entire universe is under Satan's influence and is contrary to God's will. Hence, there is a strong current in the world in opposition to the will of God. **As those who take sides with God, we find that the whole universe is against us and, in particular, against our prayer.** (Except from the Life-Studies of Colossians chapter 65, section 1)
