## General Subject: The Reality of the Body of Christ

Message Six

Living Out and Working Out the New Jerusalem to Build Up Zion as the Reality of the Body of Christ

Scripture Reading: Eph. 4:15-16; Col. 2:19; Psa. 36:8-9; Rev. 2:7; 21:18-23; 22:1-5

#### Four Principles to Live out and Work out the New Jerusalem as the Reality of the Body God's Presence

In order for us **to live out** and **work out** the New Jerusalem to build up Zion as the reality of the Body of Christ, we must hold on to this principle: (Rev. 21:22; 22:4; Exo. 25:30; Psa. 27:4-5, 8; 31:20; 91:1).

Whenever we do this or that, whether we go here or there, and whether we take this way or that way should be governed by the principle of God's presence. Do we have God's presence when we say this or go there? Do we have His smile when we say this or that? We need to be inwardly supplied with the Lord, enjoying Christ as the bread of God's presence (Exo. 25:30), and we need to do everything in His presence and according to His presence.

Like the psalmist, we need to ask the Lord to dwell in His house – which is the church and our mingled spirit today (Psa. 27:4-5). We want to dwell in the church and in the mingled spirit all the days of our life so that we may enquire in His presence and behold His beauty.

#### Being Under the Authority and Headship

In order for us to **live out** and **work out** the New Jerusalem to build up Zion as the reality of the Body of Christ, we must be **under the throne of God**, **the ruling of God**. One of the prominent features of the New Jerusalem is the throne of God and of the Lamb in the middle of the city. For us to **live out** and **work out** the New Jerusalem, we need to be **under** God's ruling presence, **under** the throne of God, giving Him the preeminence in our being and being submissive to His authority.

We need to realize that sin is lawlessness, a dethronement of God; therefore, we need to dethrone ourselves, humble ourselves, to live in our spirit, and coordinate with the saints for God's move. Also, we need to maintain a "clear sky" in our Christian life and church life in order to be filled with God's ruling presence of reigning grace. The origin of sin is Satan, who as Lucifer rebelled against God and tried to dethrone Him. When we sin, we rebel against God and remove His authority over us. Oh Lord Jesus!

#### Having the Flow and Supply of Life in the Church Life by Enjoying God

For us to **live out** and **work out** the New Jerusalem to build up Zion as the reality of the Body of Christ, we must have the flow and supply of **life**. From the throne of God and of the Lamb there's the river of **water of life** flowing and reaching all twelve gates, and on both sides of the river there's the tree of life growing, bearing fruit each month. Hallelujah!

The outstanding features of our Christian life and our church life today should the flowing river of life and the edible tree of life! The flowing river of life and the edible tree of life should be the outstanding features of our Christian life and church life for the enjoyment of God as our real Eden, our pleasure, entertainment, and joy. God wants to be our enjoyment, our pleasure, our entertainment, and our joy; we should simply enjoy God, come forward to Him, and be filled with exceeding joy!

#### Being Full of the Light of Life

For us to **live out** and **work out** the New Jerusalem to build up Zion as the reality of the Body of Christ, we must be **full** of the **light of life**. An outstanding feature of the New Jerusalem is that there's no natural or manmade light in it, for the Lamb is the lamp, and God is the light, while the city itself is a **diffuser** to express God's light to the whole universe.

The **light** of the New Jerusalem is God as the illuminating glory shining out through Christ the Redeemer as the lamp, and the entire holy city is the **diffuser** of the **divine light**; today this diffuser to spread the **divine light** is the Body of Christ.

[T]he whole city acts as a diffuser to spread the **divine light** to the whole universe; today the churches should be this way, being **full of light** and spreading the divine light everywhere, to all the people around us! When we enter into the mingled spirit and are in the church meetings, we see all things in the **light of life**; here God shepherds us, cherishes us, nourishes us, and shines on us to be the answer that we need.

### **Prayer Burden**

- 1. Lord, make us today's Zion, the group of overcomers in Your recovery. We want to be the highlight, the center and the reality of the church to build up and consummate the New Jerusalem. Cause us to be the vitalized ones who would make great resolutions in heart, overcoming anything that replaces You.
- 2. Increase in us in all things until we attain to a full-grown man. Mingle Your divinity more with our humanity until we become a **corporate** person fully married and mingled together as one entity.
- 3. Lord, we want to be the **overcomers**. May we all love You more than our self and more than our soul-life. May we take the way of the church internally, **live in the Body** and in resurrection, to be the means for You to usher in the kingdom age.
- 4. Have mercy on us, Lord, that we would always have a keen discernment of Your presence. We enthrone You in our daily lives that we may experience the flowing of the river of water of life and the rich supply of the tree of life.
- 5. Lord, revive us every morning. May we become partakers, enjoyers, of the divine nature and enjoy God as the Spirit, as love, and as light. Teach us to spend an adequate time in the morning with You that we may become persons full of light and love.
- 6. Thank You, Lord for Your life-releasing death and Your life-dispensing resurrection. May we have a daily experience of Your subjective death and the power of Your resurrection that our natural life, "I" will remain crucified on the cross all the time.

## Message 36 - A New Creation in Christ Becoming God's Righteousness Through the Second Step of Reconciliation (1)

March 04, 2019, 2018, Monday

Now we can see how four important matters are connected. The **ambition to please the Lord** is connected to the **aspiration to have a resurrected body**. Living to the Lord is related to being **ambitious to please the Lord**. If we do not live to the Lord, we cannot please Him. If we would make the Lord happy, we must live to Him. In order to live to the Lord, we must put our natural being to death. Then we shall be able to please Him. If we have such a living, we shall certainly be a **new creation**, a person living in the spirit, in the inward man. Therefore, the aspiration to have a transfigured body is connected to the ambition to please the Lord, the ambition to please the Lord is connected to living to the Lord, and living to the Lord is connected to being a new creation. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 36, section 3)

# Message 37 - A New Creation in Christ Becoming God's Righteousness Through the Second Step of Reconciliation (2)

March 05, 2019, Tuesday

The blessings of God can be found in the Holy Place, but God Himself is in the Holy of Holies. In the Holy Place are the blessings of the Spirit, the lampstand, and the incense altar. But in the Holy Place there is not the direct presence of God. In order to have God Himself, we must be reconciled further and come into the Holy of Holies. We must take the second step of reconciliation to be brought into the presence of God. This is full reconciliation. This reconciliation brings us not only out of sin, but also out of the flesh, the natural man, the natural being. Then we are brought to God and become one with Him.(Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 37, section2)

### Message 38 - The Mingling of Divinity with Humanity March 06, 2019, Wednesday

It is very important for us to realize that **every genuine Christian**, **every bona fide believer in Christ**, is a person undergoing the mingling of the divine life and nature with the human life and nature. The divine life is not only mingled with our human life, but it is mingling with it. As a result, we are divine human beings. We may also say that we are human divine beings. This is why we say that Christians are God-men. Our life is the life of a God-man, and our living, as indicated by the ephod composed of golden and linen thread, is a living of divinity mingled with humanity. Our spiritual clothing is not only linen; it is also golden. We have gold and linen woven into one garment. This is our conduct, our behavior, our character, our living. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 38, section2)

# **Message 39 - The Ministers of the New Covenant (8)** March 07, 2019, Thursday

To work together with God means that we are in Him. When we are in Him, we can bring others into Him. Only a person who is in God can bring others into God. If you are not in Him, you certainly cannot bring anyone else into Him. Our closeness to God is the measure of the result of our work. If we are far away from God, we cannot bring others close to Him. The extent to which we can bring others to God and into God is always measured by where we are with respect to God. If we are those who are one with God, then we can bring others to the very place where we are. Therefore, if we want to bring others into the Lord, we must first be in Him ourselves. The more we are in Him, the more we can reconcile others into Him. May this matter be deeply impressed upon us! (Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 39, section3)

#### Message 40 - The Ministers of the New Covenant (9) March 08, 2019, Friday

All people, the rich and the poor alike, have troubles. If as ministers of the new covenant we would help others in their suffering, how can we avoid suffering? We cannot be an exception. Instead, we must suffer and eventually experience longsuffering. Never think that as a minister you can avoid suffering. You will have some joy in your married life or family life, but you will also have suffering, probably more suffering than joy. Actually, a new covenant minister suffers more than others do. As a minister, he is one who should live a proper human life as the Lord Jesus did. The Lord suffered more than anyone else. To live a genuine human life is to suffer. Human life is a life not mainly of enjoyment but of suffering. The more we live a human life to minister Christ to others, the more we shall suffer. Hence, we need the qualification of longsuffering. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 40, section 3)
