TWO KINGDOMS

We need to see these two kingdoms—the kingdom of God and the kingdom of Satan. Eventually, the kingdom of God will swallow up the kingdom of Satan. When he was created by God, Adam was innocent. But the Pharisees, hearing this, said, This man does not cast out the demons except by Beelzebul, ruler of the demons.But knowing their thoughts, He said to them, Every kingdom divided against itself becomes desolate, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand. And if Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then will his kingdom stand? And if I, by Beelzebul, cast out the demons, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your judges But if I, by the Spirit of God, cast out the demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

- 1Jn 5:19 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies in the evil one.
- Eph 2:2-5 In which you once walked according to the age of this world, according to the ruler of the authority of the air, of the spirit which is now operating in the sons of disobedience; Among whom we also all conducted ourselves once in the lusts of our flesh, doing the desires of the flesh and of the thoughts, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest; But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, Even when we were dead in offenses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved)
- Php 2:13 For it is God who operates in you both the willing and the working for His good pleasure.
- Act 26:18 To open their eyes, to turn them from darkness to light and from the authority of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith in Me.
