#### **Scripture Readings:**

Matt 16:13 Now when Jesus came into the parts of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, Who do men say that the Son of Man is?

Matt 16:14 And they said, Some, John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.

Matt 16:15 He said to them, But you, who do you say that I am?

Matt 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.

<u>Matt 16:27</u> For the Son of Man is to come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will repay each man according to his doings.
