THE LORD'S DEALING WITH THE BELIEVERS

AT HIS COMING BACK

At the Lord's coming back, He will deal with the believers by judgment, by rapture, and by choosing.

The principle of the harvest is that fruit is harvested as it becomes ripe. There are at least three different stages of harvest:

The firstfruits will be raptured before the tribulation.

The majority of the crop will be raptured during the tribulation because they need the tribulation to cause them to mature.

The remainder or the gleanings will be harvested after the tribulation.

The Lord Jesus will exercise His judgment at the judgment seat of Christ. He will determine who among the believers will be rewarded and qualified to be His army. The fighting army of the Lord Jesus is composed of the overcoming saints who are living in the reality of the kingdom. As His army they will come with the Lord Jesus to destroy the Antichrist and his army. Then they will become co-kings with Him to rule over the earth. They will be transferred into the manifestation of the kingdom during the millennium.

Scripture Readings:

Matt. 24:39 And they did not know that judgment was coming until the flood came and took all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

Matt. 24:40 At that time two men will be in the field; one is taken and one is left.

Matt. 24:41 Two women will be grinding at the mill; one is taken and one is left.

Matt. 24:42 Watch therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord comes.

Matt. 24:43 But know this, that if the householder had known in which watch the thief was coming, he would have watched and would not have allowed his house to be broken into.

Matt. 24:44 For this reason you also be ready, because at an hour when you do not expect it, the Son of Man is coming.

1 Thes. 4:15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are living, who are left remaining unto the coming of the Lord, shall by no means precede those who have fallen asleep;

1 Thes. 4:16 Because the Lord Himself, with a shout of command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet of God, will descend from heaven, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

1 Thes. 4:17 Then we who are living, who are left remaining, will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air; and thus we will be always with the Lord.

1 Cor. 15:50 Now this I say, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, neither does corruption inherit incorruption.

1 Cor. 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed,

1 Cor. 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we will be changed.

1 Cor. 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

1 Cor. 15:54 And when this corruptible will put on incorruption and this mortal will put on immortality, then the word which is written will come to pass, "Death has been swallowed up unto victory."

2 Thes. 2:1 Now we ask you, brothers, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him,

2 Thes. 2:2 That you be not quickly shaken in mind nor alarmed, neither by a spirit nor by word nor by a letter as if by us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come.

2 Thes. 2:3 Let no one deceive you in any way, because it will not come unless the apostasy comes first and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of perdition,

2 Thes. 2:4 Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or an object of worship, so that he sits in the temple of God, setting himself forth, saying that he is God.

2 Thes. 2:8 And then the lawless one will be revealed (whom the Lord Jesus will slay by the breath of His mouth and bring to nothing by the manifestation of His coming),

2 Thes. 1:5 A plain indication of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be accounted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which also you suffer;

2 Thes. 1:6 Since it is just with God to repay with affliction those afflicting you,

2 Thes. 1:7 And to you who are being afflicted, rest with us at the revelation of the Lord Jesus from heaven with the angels of His power, in flaming fire,

2 Thes. 1:8 Rendering vengeance to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Thes. 1:9 They will pay the penalty of eternal destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His strength

2 Thes. 1:10 When He comes to be glorified in His saints and to be marveled at in all those who have believed (because our testimony to you was believed) in that day.

Phil. 3:20 For our commonwealth exists in the heavens, from which also we eagerly await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

Phil. 3:21 Who will transfigure the body of our humiliation to be conformed to the body of His glory, according to His operation by which He is able even to subject all things to Himself.

1 John 3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not yet been manifested what we will be. We know that if He is manifested, we will be like Him because we will see Him even as He is.

Rev. 2:25 Nevertheless what you have hold fast until I come.

Rev. 3:3 Remember therefore how you have received and heard, and keep it and repent. If therefore you will not watch, I will come as a thief, and you shall by no means know at what hour I will come upon you.

Rev. 16:15 (Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he who watches and keeps his garments that he may not walk naked and they see his shame.)
