The appearance of the kingdom is mainly revealed in Matthew 13 in three parables: the parable of the tares, the parable of the mustard herb becoming a great tree, and the parable of the leaven. These parables cover three very negative things.

- The tares signify those persons claim to be a Christian and yet do not believe that the Bible is inspired by God word by word, that the Lord Jesus is the Son of God, even God Himself, and that the Lord Jesus died on the cross for our redemption. The Lord Jesus will send His angels to bind the tares into bundles and to throw all of them into the lake of fire.
- The small mustard herb changed its form, its nature, and its condition to become a great tree in which the birds of heaven could lodge. The great tree signifies the church increased greatly in both numbers and popularity by the marriage with the Roman Empire since A.D. 313. Many unbelievers were baptized into Christianity, causing Christianity to become a great tree full of false ones. The birds signify the evil one, the devil who comes to snatch away the word of life from people.
