## <u>Crystallization-Study – Humanity of Christ</u>

## In the Fulfillment of the Eternal Economy of God

- Isa 32:2 And a man will be like a refuge from the wind / And a covering from the tempest, / Like streams of water in a dry place, / Like the shadow of a massive rock in a wasted land.
  - Our circumstances in our living can be like a blowing wind, and sometimes they
    can be like a tempest with heavy rain.
  - Christ is a refuge from the wind and a covering from the tempest.
- If we only had the New Testament without the Old Testament, our enjoyment of Christ would not be adequate.
  - Three sections of the Old Testament—the Law of Moses, the Prophets, and the Psalms—reveal Christ.

## The Son of Man

- Matt. 18:11 For the Son of Man has come to save that which is lost.
  - It is the Son of Man who has the authority to forgive sinners.
  - It is the Son of Man who can be the Lord of the Sabbath.
  - It is the Son of Man who gave His life as a ransom for many.
  - It is the Son of Man who gives food which abides unto eternal life.
  - It is the Son of Man who was glorified with the Father's glory.
- Christ as the Son of Man came in His humanity to seek and save the lost sinners.
  - Matt. 9:13 But go and learn what [this] means, "I desire mercy and not sacrifice," for I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners.
  - Luke 9:56 The Son of Man has not come to destroy men's lives but to save [them.] And they went into another village.
- As the Son of Man, Christ had no place to lay His head, not even as the foxes having holes nor as the birds of heaven having roosts (Matt. 8:20).
- Christ in His humanity is the Lord of the Sabbath.
- Christ as the Son of Man will confess in him, before His father in the heavens and before His angels, everyone who confesses in Him before men, and He will forgive the ones speaking words against Him.

- The Lord as the Son of Man sowed Himself, in His humanity, as the good seed into man to grow Him.
- Christ came in His humanity not to be served but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many (Matt. 20:28).
- Christ gave, in His humanity, the food which abides unto eternal life.
  - John 6:27 Work not for the food which perishes, but for the food which abides unto eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you; for Him has the Father, [even] God, sealed.
- His being lifted on the cross as the Son of Man was so that people may know that He is the great I Am and that He may draw all men to Himself.
- On the cross He was lifted up as a serpent, typified by the serpent lifted up by Moses, that everyone who believes into Him may have eternal life.
- The Son of Man was buried in His humanity in the heart of the earth three days and three nights.
- Christ resurrected in His humanity on the third day after His burial, being glorified.
