The jubilee brings us into **ecstasy**, and we get out of ourselves with excitement because we have been both released from bondage and we have been returned to our divine possession. **But** if we stay in the **excitement** and we do not heed the **warnings** [after chapter 25], we lose everything...

In Lev. 26:1-2 we are told of three main things which are crucial to our living as God's people – not having idols (not making idols), keeping Jehovah's Sabbaths, and reverencing His sanctuary. Not making idols refers to God as our unique goal and aim. Our God has been processed and consummated to come into us and indwell us. Keeping Jehovah's Sabbaths refers to the work of the Triune God, all that He has done and accomplished, and our appreciation and entering into this work by first resting in God. Reverencing God's sanctuary refers to the result of God's work, for as a result of what God is doing the church as the sanctuary of God is produced.

We should Not have Idols - God Himself should be our Unique Goal, the One we Seek

Idols refers to the heretical substitutes for the true God; an **idol** is everything and anyone that replaces the true God, the Triune God, experienced by us as our life. As those who are genuine children of a genuine God, we should be on the alert to guard ourselves from any heretical substitutes and from all vain replacements for our genuine and real God.

We have been **organically** united with God, and God is eternal life to us; we need to guard ourselves from idols and **refuse** to have any vain replacements of God. We all need to be warned concerning having idols, because this is the first thing that God wants from us – He wants that we have God as our unique goal, the only One we seek and love...May we experience the Triune God as life and refuse any substitutes or replacements of our genuine and real God!

Keeping the Sabbath

The second item we should keep, as per Lev. 26:2, is **God's Sabbaths**; keeping God's Sabbaths signifies that we should know that the work of God was done entirely by Himself so that we might enjoy it, and there's no need for us to do any work!

This sounds so good and pleasant, but we all have been taught that we need to work, so we many times want to do this "for God" but actually in our own strength, power, and purpose. It is a hard lesson for us to learn, for we have in ourselves this desire to do things for God. What God wants is not for us to work but to respect, enter into, and enjoy what God has done for us.

The truth is that although Christ has accomplished everything for us, we may not be in the enjoyment of this achievement; instead of enjoying Him and His work, we may keep on laboring and doing things, setting Christ's achievement aside. This is why the Lord encourages us to come to Him with all our toils and labors, and we will **find rest for our souls**. He has already done the work; God has accomplished all the work, and He wants us to remember this, respect this, enter into this accomplished work, and enjoy what **God has done for us**.

Reverencing His Sanctuary

What does it mean to reverence God's sanctuary? To reverence God's sanctuary is to regard it or treat it with a deep respect. In God's eyes His sanctuary is precious, worthy of the highest honor. In Exodus we see that God came to dwell among His people, and in Leviticus we see how He is training His people to live with Him a holy, clean, and rejoicing life.

A very **practical way** for us **to reverence God's sanctuary** is making sure we're at the Lord's Table Meeting **on time**, exercising our spirit to praise the Lord and offer worship to the Father. Being habitually late for the meeting, especially the Lord's Table Meeting, shows that we do not reverence God's sanctuary but rather hold it as something not so precious.

Lord Jesus, we want to reverence God's sanctuary by regarding with reverence God's dwelling place, Christ and the church. Thank You Lord for regenerating us, transforming us, and renewing us to make us part of Your dwelling place, the church as the house of God. Lord, we highly regard the church, for it is the church that is Your dwelling place, the place where You can make Your desire known. Hallelujah!

LIFE-STUDY OF 1 CORINTHIANS

"One Life-Study a Day Makes One Holy"

The Ministry of the New Covenant (2) January 21, 2018, Monday

[The Function and Competency of the Ministry of the New Covenant]

The writing that takes place in our hearts by the ministers of the new covenant has the all-inclusive life-giving Spirit as the element. This element is actually the processed God. This means that it is the Triune God who is being written into our being. This is the letter written by the ministers of the new covenant with the processed Triune God as the life-giving Spirit. God is being written into us, and as a result we become a letter of Christ. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 6, section 1)

The Ministry of the New Covenant (3) January 22, 2019, Tuesday

[The Glory and Superiority of the New Covenant]

In this message we come to the **glory of the new covenant ministry**. The **writing substance** is **inward**, but the **glory** is **outward**. The **writing element** is **hidden**, but the **glory** is **expressed**. Actually, the **glory** is the shining out of the hidden substance. Once again, we may use electricity as an illustration. The element of electricity flows into a light bulb. This element is the substance of the light that shines from within the bulb. But the shining of the light is the glory of the electricity. Hence, with electricity there is both the essence, the element, and the shining out, the glory. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 7, section 1)

The Ministers of the New Covenant (1) January 23, 2019, Wednesday

[Constituted by and with the Lord as the Life-giving and Transforming Spirit]

According to 2 Corinthians 4, we are **vessels**. As vessels we need to have an **unveiled face**; that is, we need to be open to the divine life with its power, essence, and shape. As we open to the Lord, He as the life-giving Spirit enters into our being to infuse His life essence into us, to operate within us by His life power, and to shape us into His image. This is the constitution of life to make us ministers of the new covenant.(Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 8, section 3)

The Ministers of the New Covenant (2)

January 24, 2019, Thursday

[Conducting Themselves for the Shinning of the Gospel of the Glory of Christ]

Only when we have such **direct**, **personal**, and **intimate** contact with the Lord do we have the inner shining. This is just as true of us as it is of an unbeliever coming to the Lord for the first time. If we would have the Lord's shining once again, we need to have intimate contact with the Lord. Whenever we call on the Lord in a dear, intimate way, we are before His face, and the shining of God is in our heart. In this way the apostles received the inner shining. Then they shined out what they had received. This was their way of conducting themselves for the shining of the glory of the gospel of Christ. The power for this shining is that spoken of in verse 7. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 9, section 4)

The Ministers of the New Covenant (3) January 25, 2019, Friday

[Living a Crucified Life for the Manifestation of the Resurrection Life by the Excellent Power of the Treasure in the Earthen Vessel]

The **continual daily grinding works for a specific purpose**: that the life of Jesus might be manifested in our body. This life is resurrection life. The Lord Jesus lived resurrection life even before He was crucified. The life He lived on earth was a life of resurrection. This resurrection life is a life that can withstand being put to death. (Excerpt from the Life-Study of 2 Corinthians, chapter 10, section 3)
