# HWMR Week 7 Knowing Jehovah, the Eternal God, in His Lovingkindness, Compassions, and Faithfulness

Lovingkindness means tender affection. God's lovingkindness, His tender affection, includes His mercy, love, care, and kindness. We may have had the experience of knowing that we deserved a severe dealing for what we had done, but instead, we received His kindness, which melted our heart...We can approach the throne through the blood of Jesus, and there we will meet lovingkindness. We cannot live without it. If there were only righteousness, we would have been consumed a long time ago. God is always righteous, but His righteousness is the basis for Him to display His lovingkindness.

The people of Israel had failed but God's compassions preserved the remnant for the carrying out of His economy. Compassion is deeper, finer and richer than mercy. Mercy is precious and we cannot live without God's mercy; however, compassion issues from the depths of God's being. In Luke 6:36 we see God's compassion being wrought into our being. The Lord said, "Be full of compassion, even as your Father also is full of compassion." Our being full of compassion will affect our gospel testimony and our contacting of fallen, ungodly people. We cannot put on a mask of compassion. When we are full of God's compassion, we will deeply and inwardly grieve for them. Let us be open to be filled with compassion.

Jehovah's compassions "are new every morning" (Lam. 3:23). What a wonderful way to start the day, to begin with God's new compassions. [We] need new compassions every morning. [Our] days are much different when, by being open, [we] receive new compassions from the Lord. Receiving His new compassions every morning does something to our inner being. God's compassions do not fail, because He is the faithful One. Tomorrow morning, before we wake up, before we are even alert, God's compassions will be there because of His faithfulness.

Lamentations 3:25 says, "Jehovah is good to those who wait on Him, / To the soul that seeks Him." Although God is true, living compassionate, and faithful, in order to test His people, He often delays in fulfilling His word (Psa. 27:14). Perhaps we all can testify of having this experience in different degrees. I can say that I have spent most of my life waiting on God, not every moment but again and again. Nevertheless, I can testify that my God is righteous; He is faithful. God is faithful to do what He has spoken. (Excerpt from the Ministry of the Word, Vol 24, No. 6, pp. 185-211)

To wait on the Lord is very crucial. God is our portion; He is full of lovingkindness and compassion; and He is absolutely faithful. Now we need to hope in Him, wait on Him, and call upon Him.
