The Experience of Reigning

We must seek the experience of reigning. For this, two things must not be lacking.

Knowing Our Position

First, we must know our position...[T]he basis of spiritual authority is the **position of ascension**. To have power depends on one's **condition**, but to have authority depends on one's **position**. A car with sufficient gasoline and horsepower will have power. This is a matter of condition. But a traffic policeman standing at his assigned post has authority to direct the cars, that they may proceed in order. This is a matter of position. Therefore, **authority depends entirely on position**. If we are in the position of ascension, we have authority and can reign. If we are not in the position of ascension, we do not have authority and cannot rule.

Even in the case of the Lord Jesus, the basis of reigning depended on His position of ascension. Not until after His resurrection and ascension did He obtain all authority in heaven and on earth (Matt. 28:18) and have dominion over all things (Eph. 1:20-22). Therefore, if we would reign, we must be in the position of ascension.

But if we want to be in the position of ascension and reign for God, we need to accept all the dealings of the cross, that we may pass through death into resurrection and thereby experience ascension. In other words, the experience of reigning is the result of all the foregoing experiences. Only after we have experienced death, resurrection, and ascension, can we obtain the experience of reigning.

God's children today show forth very little of the **reality of reigning**. The main reason is that we are not in the position of ascension. Many still live in an earthly condition. They are still involved with sins and the world. They have not put off the flesh and their temper. They have not denied the self and their natural constitution. There are some who have put these off and have a little experience of ascension, yet because they cannot maintain this experience, they become defiled again with those things pertaining to the old creation; thus, they lose the position of ascension. Both conditions can cause us to lose the basis of reigning, and as a consequence we cannot rule for God.

Desiring to Reign

Second, we must have the desire to reign. This means that we must positively and actively reign for God, ruling over all things. Once we have the position of ascension and order, we may reign. If our experience has reached this stage, we ought to reign. Some brothers and sisters, however, have neither the thought nor the desire to reign. Their spirits are loose and lazy. They neither care for the difficulties arising in the church nor inquire about the problems springing up in the Lord's work. They simply allow Satan to work and destroy at will. Hence, according to their growth of life, they are able to reign, yet in reality, due to their laxity and unwillingness to reign, they still cannot obtain the experience of reigning. Therefore, if one desires to reign, his spirit must not be lax or timid but willing to exercise God's authority and positively and actively deal with all the works of the enemy. Thus, God's authority will immediately be manifested in the church, and many rebellious and unlawful matters in the church will be subdued.

Misaiming Concerning the Kingdom

<u>Misaiming</u>: "...all things you have prayed about will work together for good. You see, the Apostle Paul is the one who wrote this verse, and he didn't even believe that everything which happened worked together for good... We make a mistake when we try to make Romans 8:28 fit into every situation in life, when Paul used it only in reference to praying in the Spirit"

(Charles Capps, Kicking Over Sacred Cows, 1987, pp. 184-185).

<u>Truth:</u> The key word for understand how "all things work together for good" is because in verse 29: Because those whom He foreknew, He also predestinated to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the Firstborn among many brothers." All things specifically work together for good to conform us to the image of His Son. Good does not refer to some temporal pleasure, happiness, or improvement in circumstance. If this we so, then verse 28 surely would not "fit into every situation in life." This verse is applicable only when we realize, from the perspective of God's economy, that this "good" is the result of the inward activity of the indwelling Christ who desires to spread in our being. This activity is aided by "all things," and it has the consummate goal of making us sons of God who are so constituted with Christ that we become His expression. When a believer sees the truth of God's economy, he is freed from slavery to environments, situations, and conditions. When we see that the consummate good is our conformation to Christ, then all things in our environment will serve us by helping us to rely and focus on the subjective Christ, the One who desire to "make His home in your hearts" (Eph. 3:17) (Charles Capps, Kicking Over Sacred Cows, 1987, pp. 184-185).
