The Divine Dispensing of the Divine Trinity for the Divine Economy—Week 6

Our Experience of the Miraculous Normality

These three items—regeneration, being filled with the Spirit essentially, and being filled with the Spirit economically—cover the entire Christian life. Justification, redemption, forgiveness of sins, and the washing away of sins are included in regeneration. Sanctification, transformation, renewing, conformation, and glorification are included in the inner filling of the Spirit. The authority of the Lord, the position in the ascended Christ, the clothing of the Spirit of power as the uniform for ministry, the miraculous gifts such as speaking in tongues and healing, and all the activities of power are included in the outpouring of the Spirit upon us.

Regeneration, the infilling of the Spirit, and the outpouring of the Spirit, though miraculous, are very normal. If a sinner would be regenerated, he merely listens to the gospel and believes every item of the gospel. Then based on his believing, he calls on the Savior's name. Romans 10:9 says, "If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." One minute before, this person was an unregenerated sinner, but the next minute, he is a regenerated saint. One minute ago, he was a son of the devil, but the next minute he is a son of God. Although regeneration is normal, it is also a great miracle. D. L. Moody said that regeneration was the greatest miracle among all the miracles. Regeneration is a great miracle because a devilish man becomes a divine man; that is, a son of the devil immediately becomes a son of God. Regeneration is the greatest miracle, yet it takes place in such a normal way. Thus, regeneration is a normality that is miraculous. It is a miraculous normality in our Christian life.

To be filled with the Spirit is also very normal. In order to be filled with the Spirit, we just need to fulfill the conditions, or terms. We need to make a thorough confession of our sins, pray to the Lord, and exercise our faith. When we believed in the Lord and were regenerated, we received an allotted faith (2 Pet. 1:1). This faith is within us, and we must use it. We must exercise our faith. I usually eat a very nourishing breakfast every morning that supplies me with much energy. But during the day I have to energize; that is, I have to exercise my energy. A starving person could not exercise his energy, because he has no energy with which to exercise. The food that we have taken in is converted to the energy that we exercise. In like manner, we all have received the God-allotted faith. We have faith within us, so we can exercise this faith (Excerpts from The Scriptural Way to Meet and to Serve for the Building Up of the Body of Christ, CWWL, 1987, vol. 3).

The Divine Dispensing for the Divine Economy

The divine dispensing comes out of the three of the Divine Trinity—the Father, the Son, and the Spirit. The divine dispensing taking place within us is the operating of the all-inclusive life-giving Spirit, the pneumatic Christ, as the aggregate, totality, and consummation of the Triune God. This Spirit is moving in us, anointing us, watering us, feeding us, satisfying us, strengthening us, comforting us, saturating us, and permeating us. There are so many words to describe His dispensing within us. All the foregoing items...are matters of dispensing. Every day we should be built up by receiving the divine dispensing within us.

We should not expect to have a spectacular time each day in receiving the divine dispensing...We must learn to be satisfied with ordinary days that are filled with regular and normal practices in the divine dispensing. In the morning we should have some time with the Lord to touch Him and be revived by Him. Then we need to pass through a daily routine to get ready for work. To live a life in the divine dispensing in a normal way will make us healthy both physically and spiritually. Whether or not we have good or bad days is not up to us; it is up to His sovereignty. He has already chosen us, and it is too late to turn back. We are blessed because the processed and consummated Triune God is within us. He is in us, not in a spectacular way but in a very ordinary way...We should be blessed to be satisfied with ordinary days in the divine dispensing. The Triune God is certainly in us, but His being in us is not spectacular. Every day He is within us dispensing and positively strengthening and encouraging us...Our Father God has destined that we live in an ordinary way under His continual dispensing (The Divine Dispensing for the Divine Economy, CWWL, 1990, vol.3).

The tortoise wins the race. If we keep going slowly, we will win the race. All the "running ones" will be defeated, but the working ones will win the race. We need to eat regularly, continuously, and slowly. I advise you not to go too fast but to go slowly. You will then reach the goal. If we had started this practice ten years ago, we would have finished the entire New Testament already. Even if you get through half of the New Testament, you will see that you are different. Also, if the entire church could get through half of the New Testament, the church would be different (CWWL, 1984, vol. 2, "Elders' Training, Book 3," ch. 13, p. 362).
