Church in Regina

Laboring on the All-Inclusive Christ Typified by the Good Land for the Building Up of the Church as the Body of Christ, for the Reality and the Manifestation of the Kingdom, and for the Bridge to Make Herself Ready for the Lord's Coming—Week 7

Song of songs 4:8 says, "Come with me from Lebanon, my bride; with me from Lebanon, my bride; / With me from Lebanon come. / Look from the top of Amana, / From the top of Senir and Hermon, / From the lions' dens, / From the leopards/ mountains." In this verse the Lord as typified by Solomon calls His lover to be one with Him in His ascension. The Lord will make this call to each one of us. Receiving this call is not a basic or elementary experience. In the Experience of Life Brother Lee indicates that our experience of knowing the ascension is an experience in the fourth stage, the final stage, of the experience of life, which is also an experience in the context of knowing the Body.

The Lord's call to His lover to live in ascension is a call to come to where He is. In His ascension Christ asks us to look with Him from the top of several mountains, signifying certain spiritual experiences. In ascension we see and experience Lebanon, a high mountain signifying that ascension is the peak of Christ's resurrection.

As we are in ascension, we not only look at these marvelous positive aspects of the all-inclusive Christ who will become our Husband; we also look from the lions' dens and from the leopards' mountains, which signifies the heavenlies, where Satan and his subordinates are. In ascension we need to have a clear view of them and know how to engage in spiritual warfare with them based upon Christ's victory.

In His ascension Christ was also made the High Priest in the heavens to bear us in the presence of God and to care for all our needs; in His ascension He was inaugurated into His priestly office. In His ascension He is interceding for us continually. When we meet the Lord, He may reveal to us the times when the enemy tried to harm us, yet He was interceding for us and saved us. He is bearing us before God on His heart. Because we have weaknesses, we will experience certain kinds of failures repeatedly. However, when we suffer these kinds of failures, the Lord does not come in and say, "What are you doing? You are going to be in outer darkness for a thousand years. Why don't you stop this?" We will experience judgment, but He is interceding for us. He understands the source of our weakness. He ministers life to us as our High Priest. On the one hand, Christ is the High Priest interceding in the heavens for the churches; on the other hand, He is the High Priest moving in the churches to care for them.

Christ cares not only for all the saints and every family; He cares for all the churches. He cares for the church in New York City; He cares for the church in London. He knows the condition and the need of every church. Revelation 2 and 3 reveal how the Lord speaks to the churches. He did not say that He speaks to the elders; He speaks to the messengers, yet a messenger may be an elder.

We know from Revelation how much the Son of Man loves and cares for all the churches. Whereas the priests in the Old Testament were girded at the loins for their ministry, Christ is girded about the breasts in Revelation 1:13, signifying His care in love for the churches. His golden girdle signifies divine strength. Christ is moving in the churches to care for them in His humanity and with His divine strength. He is caring, ministering, and praying for the churches. He is the high priest moving in the churches to care for each church (Excerpts from the Ministry of the Word, vol. 28, no. 2, pp. 169-186).
