

Church in Regina

Laboring on the All-Inclusive Christ Typified by the Good Land for the Building Up of the Church as the Body of Christ, for the Reality and the Manifestation of the Kingdom, and for the Bride to Make Herself Ready for the Lord's Coming—Week 10

In Genesis 13:15 God said to Abraham, "All the land that you see I will give to you and to your seed forever." This shows that **the land that we see is the land that we will possess**. In verse 17 He said, "Rise up; walk through the land according to its length and its breadth, for I will give it to you." On the one hand, we need to **see the land**; on the other hand, we need to **walk through the land**. We **possess the land** by seeing the land and by walking through the land.

The good land today is Christ as the all-inclusive Spirit (Gal. 3:14), who dwells in our spirit (2 Tim. 4:22; Rom. 8:16) to be our enjoyment. It is spectacular that Paul saw that **the blessing of Abraham is the all-inclusive Spirit**. The physical aspect of the blessing that God promised to Abraham was the good land, and the good land is a type of the all-inclusive Christ as the all-inclusive life-giving Spirit for our experience. **It is very important to see that the good land is a type of the Spirit for our experience.**

To **walk** in Christ, that is, to walk according to the spirit and by the Spirit as the reality of the good land, we must **see** that the key of the spiritual fellowship of the regenerated tripartite believers with the consummated Triune God is 1 Corinthians 6:17 – "**He who is joined to the Lord is one spirit**." The term "one spirit" refers to the mingling of the Lord as the Spirit with our spirit to be a mingled spirit. This is confirmed by the following verses: **1 Cor. 15:45b** says that the last Adam became a **life-giving Spirit**; **2 Cor. 3:17** says that the Lord is **the Spirit**; and **Romans 8:16** says, "The Spirit Himself witnesses with **our spirit** that we are children of God." The witnessing Spirit in Romans 8:16 is the Lord in 2 Corinthians 3:17. When we put these verses together with **1 Cor. 6:17**, we see that the divine Spirit dwells in our human spirit and that these two spirits are mingled together to become one **mingled spirit**.

We may say that our spirit is a joined spirit because **our spirit is joined to the Lord who is the Spirit**, the Lord Spirit (2 Cor. 3:18). This is an awesome revelation. I remember the first time someone showed me the difference between Spirit with an uppercase S and spirit with a lowercase s. I had never seen this before. John 3:6 says, "That which is born of the Spirit is spirit." We also see these two spirits in **John 4:24**: "God is **Spirit**, and those who worship Him must worship in **spirit** and truthfulness," and in **Romans 8:16**: "The **Spirit** Himself witnesses with our **spirit** that we are children of God."

The secret of God's organic salvation is the Spirit Himself with our spirit. God's organic salvation is clearly referred to Romans 5:10, "which says, 'If we, being enemies, were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more we will be saved in His life, having been reconciled.'" **We were once God's enemies, but we "were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more..."** I love these two words "**much more**". We are the "much more" believers. "Much more we will be saved in His life," that is, in His zoe, which is the divine, eternal life. To be saved in His life is God's organic salvation. Actually, this organic salvation is *our deification*. Our organic salvation is our being deified to become the same as God in life, nature, and function but not in the Godhead. We should never take this for granted (Excerpts from the Ministry of the Word, Vol. 28, No. 02, pp. 243-267).
