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Experiencing, Enjoying, and Expressing Christ (1) - Week 6

The Bible is the autobiography of the Triune God. The Bible was written by the Triune God about the Triune God. If we were to provide a definition of the Bible, it would be "The Autobiography of the Triune God – the Two sections of Eternity and the Bridge of time". God's autobiography actually becomes our biography. He chose us to be holy before the foundation of the world in eternity past. Then in eternity future, we become, by being united, mingled and incorporated with Him, the holy city, the New Jerusalem. In short, we were chosen to be holy in eternity past, and we will become the holy city in eternity future. To be holy is to be fully separated unto and saturated with God.

God is the journeying Triune God. The destination of the journeying Triune God is man's spirit. Praise the lord that He stepped out of eternity into time with His divinity into humanity. In the Old Testament He moved indirectly among men, but in the New Testament He moves within man. Today God is moving in man. God came into humanity. He was united, mingled, and incorporated with humanity. He passed through incarnation, human living, crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension to become the all-inclusive, life-giving, outpoured Spirit. As such a Spirit He could enter into our spirit. Today He is still journeying in us. His journeying has not stopped. Through regeneration He journeyed into us, and He is journeying in us to bring us through sanctification, renewing, transformation, conformation, glorification, and building up. Eventually, He is united, mingled, and incorporated with us at the end of the bridge of time as the New Jerusalem for the thousand-year kingdom. Then all of God's children will be incorporated together into the New Jerusalem, and following that He will step off the bridge of time with us. We become Him, and He becomes us. When we look at Him, we see ourselves, and when we look at ourselves, we see Him. Praise the Lord that we will become Him in life and in nature but not in the Godhead (Excerpts from The Ministry of the Word, vol. 21, p. 09, p. 58-59).
