Experiencing, Enjoying, and Expressing Christ (1) - Week 11

Built Up by the Constant Visitation to the Redeemed Elect of the Father and the Son with the Spirit

The Father's house is built up by the constant visitation to the redeemed elect of the Father and the Son with the Spirit who indwells the redeemed elect to be the mutual dwelling place of the consummated Triune God and His redeemed elect. In 14:23 the Lord Jesus said, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word, and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make an abode with him." Verse 2 tells us that in the Father's house there are many abodes, and in verse 23 we see that these abodes are built up by the Father and the Son's visitation to those who love Him. The Spirit is not explicitly mentioned in verse 23 but rather is implied, for the Spirit dwells in the regenerated spirit of all those who love the Lord Jesus.

From our experience we know that the Father and the Son pay us a constant visitation. In our daily life the Father and the Son often come to visit us. We may be at home, at school, or at work, but wherever we may be, the Father and the Son come to visit us to do a building work in us, making an abode that will be a mutual dwelling place for the Triune God and for us. This is the building up of the Father's house through the constant visitation of the Triune God...

The Function of the Father's House

God is the Owner of the entire universe, so in this universe there should be a house in which He can dwell.

For the Processed and Consummated Triune God to Have a Mutual Abode
The Father's house is for the processed and consummated Triune God to have
a mutual abode with the redeemed and regenerated believers in Christ.

For Christ to Make His Home in the Hearts of His Believers
This house is also for Christ, the embodiment of the processed Triune God, to
make His home in the hearts of His believers who are strengthened into their
inner man by the Father, according to the riches of His glory, with power
through His Spirit unto the fullness (expression) of the processed Triune God.

For the Invisible and Mysterious Triune God to Have a Household and a Kingdom The Father's house is for the invisible and mysterious Triune God to have a visible and solid household constituted by the children of God, the species of God, with His divine life for their growth in life and for His rest, satisfaction, and manifestation. The house of God is the church, and the church is Christ because every member of the church is Christ. The church is the composition of all the parts of Christ.

The Father's house is also for the invisible and mysterious Triune God to have a kingdom, composed of the believers in Christ as the citizens, in two aspects. First, the kingdom of God as the church life in this age is for the believers' exercise and equipping in the divine authority. Second, the kingdom of Christ in the kingdom age is for the overcoming saints to reign with Christ over all the nations (Excerpts from The Issue of Christ Being Glorified by the Father with the Divine Glory, chs 4 and 6).

PRAYER BURDENS

- 1. Lord, we believe not only in You objectively, but into You subjectively. Unveil us to see the matter of the Father's house—the church, Your dwelling place on earth. Make us Your habitation today.
- 2. Thank You, Lord for Your death and resurrection. You paved the way and prepared the place so that we might be brought into God. Thank You, that now we have a standing before God and in God.
- We praise You for Your coming and going. Your coming brought God into man and Your going brought us into God. Continue to build up God's house by building Yourself into us day by day.
- 4. Lord, we desire Your constant visitation. Continue to dispense Yourself into us that we may be built together. Grant us experiences that we may abide in You and You in us. Keep us in Your presence and strengthen us to say "Amen, Lord Jesus" in every situation.
- 5. Help us realize that in ourselves, we can do nothing and that everything depends on God. You are our Father and the Initiator of everything. Thank You for being our source and sharing us Your life.
- 6. Lord, we want to see the intrinsic significance of living in the church as the Father's house. Bring us into a living in the Triune God as life, living in the light, in resurrection, in grace and reality, in the divine glory, in a house of prayer and worship, living a life of shepherding, for God's building, for the keeping of oneness and in the divine and human incorporation.
