Experiencing, Enjoying, and Expressing Christ (1) - Week 12

The **kingdom of God** is **the spreading of Christ as life** into His believers to form a realm in which God rules in His life. **To enter** into this kingdom, people need to **repent** of their sins and **believe in the gospel** so that their sins may be forgiven and so that they may **be regenerated** by God to have the divine life, which matches the divine nature of this kingdom. When was the last time that someone for whom we were burdened was saved and immediately had a thorough repentance and confession due to the ever brighter shining of the Lord's light and His leading? ...[T]he repentance and confession opened that person's being so that more of the resurrection power could penetrate into them. This is better than helping this person to be saved by saying, "All you need to do to be saved is to say, 'Lord Jesus, forgive me. Thank You for saving me.'" Although such a prayer is better than nothing, **people need to repent of their sins and believe in the gospel so that their sins may be forgiven.** Perhaps we may then be able to say, "Now that you have confessed, God has forgiven you. When God forgives, He forgets..." Sometimes, the enemy would bother me and say, "Your confession was not thorough enough, so do it again." Eventually, while I was confessing something again, the Lord broke in and said, "I do not know what you are talking about. I have forgiven you, and I have forgotten about that." I do not know how God forgets, but I want to say from deep within, "Thank You for being a forgetting God." When we confess, He forgives and forgets.

In Acts 19 we see that **Satan is fighting against God's spreading of His kingdom on earth**; the prevailing ministry for the propagation of Christ is a fighting, a battle, for God's kingdom... Satan is fighting against God's spreading of His kingdom on earth, and **we are fighting for the spreading of God's kingdom on the earth.** We are fighting under the authority of the victorious Christ, and we are sitting with Him in the heavenlies looking down at the enemy in the air to declare Christ's victory. We can say to the enemy, "The Body is being built up, the army is being trained, and we are ready for battle. We are becoming the New Jerusalem, and you will first be bound and thrown into the abyss. Then we will let you come out and do the same old evil thing you did before. Ultimately, there is a special place for you—the lake of fire. While you are in the lake of fire, we will be married to the Triune God." Praise the Lord!

To teach concerning Christ is to spread the kingdom of God; therefore, the kingdom of God is actually **the propagation of the resurrected Christ**—a process that continues to be carried out through the believers today. We are the believers, and we are in the kingdom. We have the Spirit of Jesus. We are engaged in spiritual warfare against Satan's kingdom. We are looking forward to a glorious victory, and we are waiting for the time when what is prophesied in Revelation 19:7 will be spoken into the depths of our being: "Let us rejoice and exult, and let us give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." **Let us all continue to proclaim the gospel of the kingdom, experience the Spirit of Jesus, and be included in the bride who is making herself ready.** Then the very next step will be our being invited to the marriage feast.
