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Living A Christian Life and Church Life Under the Government of God for the Economy of God—Week 6

We need to experience the development of the divine life and the divine nature contained in the divine seed that has been sown into us so that we may have a rich entrance into the eternal kingdom (vv. 1, 4-11). **In order to have a rich entrance into the eternal kingdom, there must be the development of the divine life. No one can bring this about in someone else.** This is a matter of our **personal relationship with the Lord**. We must carefully consider whether or not we have a personal relationship with the Lord. In the church life we are all partaking of the divine life and nature, but we are all at different stages. I hope that we all would have a personal contact with the Lord and say, "Lord, You know where I am. You know what I need. I need to experience and enjoy You. Lord, please train me to have a personal relationship with You." We all need this. Otherwise, inwardly there will be a delay to our growing in life. Some saints are very diligent, active, and faithful in the church life, yet they have not grown at all for thirty years. The Lord needs to lead them to another stage; there has to be this kind of development.

By developing these virtues, we grow in life, and eventually we will reach maturity, be full of Christ, and be qualified and equipped to be kings in the coming kingdom (Eph. 4:13-15; Col. 2:19; 2 Pet. 1:11). It is by developing these virtues that we grow in life and reach maturity. There is not just an objective teaching. There is a loving concern for all of us that this development will take place. The Lord can do a lot in the next thirty days. A month from now, may the Lord be able to say, "You are proceeding. You are developing." It is normal to develop. In the seven years from the age of twelve to nineteen, children undergo a radical change in every part of their being. This is a picture of normal development.

We must grow to reach maturity. Maturity is a stage of growth in life, and there are various degrees of maturity. We do not have to be on the same level as Brothers Watchman Nee and Witness Lee, but we must enter the realm of maturity. When we are twelve, we are a child. When we are twenty-five, we are no longer a child but a young adult, and we remain in this realm of adulthood for the rest of our life. It is the same on the spiritual side. It does not take that long to reach the realm of maturity, to be full of Christ. **We must be qualified and equipped to be kings.** I hope there is **a personal realization within us** that we need this. Surely, the Lord is waiting for us to realize this and to know it in reality. Then as we are an open vessel before Him, He can do all that is in His heart for us. He knows how to take us on from step to step so that we may participate in His being (Excerpts from the Ministry of the Word, Vol. 29, no. 1, 137-156).
