## Chapters 5 Through 8 of Romans—The Kernel of the Bible—Week 5

Through His Indwelling, Christ Applying to Us All That He Has Accomplished through His Death, Resurrection, and Ascension

...Christ has come to indwell our being to be our life (Col. 3:4), and **by His indwelling He applies to us all that He accomplished** through His death, resurrection, and ascension. We may compare the application of Christ's death, resurrection, ascension, and indwelling to typesetting and printing. In order to print something, we first need to set the type and make a plate. Once this is done, we can apply the type to many sheets of paper through the process of printing. The image on every printed page is the same as that on the plate. Christ has accomplished the "typesetting" by His death, resurrection, and ascension. Now He has come into us to "print," to impress into us, all that He has accomplished. In this way He fully, thoroughly, and wholly makes us copies of Himself. This is accomplished by the indwelling Christ...

**If we see the vision** that the crucified, resurrected, and ascended Christ is dwelling in us, **He will be not only the supplying Christ but also the killing Christ to us.** If we are unhappy with our wife, the killing Christ who lives in us will cut off our natural life. We do not need anyone to remind us to behave properly. **The indwelling Christ bothers us within.** This indwelling Christ is not the eternal Word before passing through incarnation, crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension. Rather, He is the Word who became flesh, tasted human life, passed through death and resurrection, and is now in the third heaven. Therefore, He is constituted with divinity as the nature of God, humanity as the nature of man, crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension, including the headship over all things, and many other items. All these are included in Him to become His constitution. We may compare this to an all-inclusive dose of medicine. **One "dose" of Christ takes care of our every need.** Everything is included in the indwelling Christ as the all-inclusive dose.

### The Indwelling Christ Being the Life-giving Spirit

The indwelling Christ today is the life-giving Spirit. Some are offended by this teaching and consider it heretical. They say that Christ is the Son, the second person of the Godhead, and therefore we should not say that Christ is the Spirit. However, the Bible says, "The last Adam became a life-giving Spirit" (1 Cor. 15:45b), and "The Lord is the Spirit" (2 Cor. 3:17a). Both the last Adam and the Lord are Christ. After His incarnation, crucifixion, and resurrection, the Lord became the Spirit who gives life. As the eternal Word, Christ became flesh to be the Lamb of God (John 1:29), and He died on the cross to solve all the problems in the universe and to deal with all the negative things. Then He, as the one grain of wheat, resurrected to produce the many grains, and He ascended to the heavens to bring all His members with Him and to afford, furnish, and equip them for their functions in His Body. Now as such a One, He is the Spirit. **We do not care for the traditional doctrines concerning the Trinity. We care only for the pure Word of God** (Excerpts from The Producing and Building Up of the Church as the Totality of the Divine Sonship (CWWL, 1977, vol. 1, p. 396-400).

# PRAYER BURDENS

1. Lord, unveil to us the focus and center of the divine revelation—the Triune God becoming our content, so we can experience You in a subjective way and be transformed to be Your full expression as the New Jerusalem.
2. Lord, we allow You to settle in us and make home in us so that in our experience, we can live in the spirit and not in the flesh. We stand by Your word that we are no longer in the flesh but in the spirit.

6. Lord, keep spreading in our being – from our spirit to our soul – and saturate us with Yourself as life. We open ourselves to You until we become persons filled with life, even to our mortal bodies.
