## The Preparation of the Bride—Week 3

We have heard fellowship about our need to be overcomers. **An overcomer is a normal Christian, a normal believer**; we do not need to be an extraordinary believer to be an overcomer. An overcomer is a believer who is **growing day by day** with the increase of Christ so that he eventually reaches maturity. We all have this opportunity before us. On the one hand, we may be middle-aged and think that we have not lived a successful Christian life, that we have not accomplished much, and that we have been a failure in many ways. On the other hand, we may be young and think that we do not have enough time to be an overcomer and be prepared as the bride, that we cannot do it or make it. We should forget about all such thoughts. This is not a time for introspection. This is a time for us to **grow steadily, day by day**, with the increase of Christ in our being. **We all have this opportunity.** May we all consecrate ourselves afresh to the Lord in the coming days so that He can gain the bride that He has been longing for.

If we are **reading** this word, it is because God intends for us to **receive** this word and to **live** according to this word. We all have the opportunity to be the overcomers who will be the bride for Christ. **The Lord is speaking to us** and His desire is being transmitted into us so that we would cooperate with Him. Hence, **we should not count ourselves out.** We need to pray to bind the enemy. We must not agree with the lies of the accuser. Every one of us reading this message can be an overcomer and be a part of the bride for Christ. This is why we were created, have been regenerated, and came into the church life. This is also why we are reading this word. This word is for each and every one of us, whether we are young or old. Let us thank the Lord for His mercy that we can receive this speaking!

...In these days I believe that the Lord desires to purify us and to make His home in our hearts so that we can actually be constituted as the bride of Christ. **This loving relationship, this fantastic romance between God and His people, is the greatest matter in the universe.** We should hate the fact that we sometimes have a lukewarm reaction to what is being spoken. We are not here to be lukewarm. We are here to be burning in our love for the Lord. May the Lord infuse us with His love day by day so that He can gain us as His bride. This is His ultimate move. Through the years of church history, the Lord has recovered many truths in the Bible and the many practices, including the proper way to meet, that enable us to experience Christ. His ultimate move, however, is to gain us as the Body of Christ and the bride for Himself. We praise the Lord for where we are, for who we are, and for what He is doing among us! May we fully empty and unload ourselves of what we think we know so that we can come to the Lord in a fresh way.

**Our problem is that we may be lukewarm.** In Revelation 3 the Lord spoke to the church in Philadelphia, which represents the recovered church, and also to Laodicea, which is basically the degraded Philadelphia. In verses 15 and 16 He said to Laodicea, "I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. So, because you are lukewarm and neither hot nor cold, I am about to spew you out of My mouth." We do not want to be Laodicea. We do not want to be those who are lukewarm. **May we not receive the matter of the preparation of the bride in a common way as if it were just a news item.** May the Lord burn in our hearts to love Him with the first love (Excerpts from Ministry of the Word, vol. 29, No. 06, pp.66-68).

# PRAYER BURDENS

1. Lord, bring us on to maturity – not only being transformed metabolically but also reaching the fullness of life. May we live in fellowship with You. Do impart Your divine life to us again and again until we reach maturity.
2. Lord, we care for Your heart's desire to keep Your commandments and grow and mature by the Father's life within us. May we grow in the spiritual life by holding to truth in love and growing up into You as the Head in all things.
