Go therefore and disciple all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
~ Matt.28:19

If we would **know the Triune God**, we must **be in the line of life and in the process of the growth in life**; the more we grow in life, the more we will be concerned with the Divine Trinity (2:13-18). **Knowing the Triune God should occupy us throughout the day.** We should not try to do this in an outward way. We can simply know Him in our being all the time, because we are in the Triune God and we realize that the Triune God is in us, unlimited, flowing, and saturating...

The more we grow in life, the more we will **be concerned** with the Divine Trinity. **We should not try to make ourselves concerned.** We should simply open our being so that the divine life can grow in us. Then **effortlessly**, our inner sense will be increasingly focused on the Divine Trinity.

We know the Triune God not in the vastness of the universe but in the personal realm of our heart (Heb. 8:10-11). Again, I have a very deep, loving concern. Day after day, I pray a prayer as if never before, as if it is a brand-new prayer: "Lord, lead and shepherd the saints to grow in life. Please give them the burden to pray to grow in life." We should **realize** that as the Lord strengthens us into our inner man, **we come to know the Triune God in the personal realm of our heart**; each one of us needs to have **a personal relationship** with the Lord...

There are **two ways** that might help us begin to have such a personal relationship with the Lord. The first way is to **bring this to the Lord in prayer** and say, "Lord, I don't know how, I don't know what to do, and I don't know how to start, but I want to have a personal relationship with You, beginning today and going on forever." The second way is to **seek some fellowship** with an older brother or sister in whom we have confidence. This saint may suggest, based on our present situation, that we pray-read through a specific book in the New Testament, like 1 John or Colossians.

According to the Bible, there is no such thing as the church being merely in God; rather, the church is in the processed Triune God (2 Cor. 13:14). I believe that many saints of all ages, especially maturing older saints, can testify that when they came into the Lord's recovery, they knew that this was where the Lord wanted them to be. Eventually, we realized that here **we are under the direction of the processed Triune God and that we have entered into the realm of being processed in our daily living.** When we first came into the Lord's recovery, we may have thought that this was just another religious group. However, we eventually realized that this is another realm. In the church life the Lord began to shine on us to clear the past, the memories, our past actions, and many other things. **We are still in a process today.** When we first consecrated ourselves in an honest way, we gave the Lord access through this life to bring us under the processed Triune God. This process will take decades and is going on year after year. This is a normal thing. Consider the brothers currently in the full-time training. Fifteen years ago, they were little boys, but today, they are men. Similarly, the sisters are no longer little girls; they are women. This is a picture of our situation in the processed Triune God.

On our side, if we have at least an initial view of the processed Triune God, then based on our present understanding, we can pray, "**Lord, I'm fully open to You for You to do Your processing work. I don't want to hold You back.**" Do not worry. **The Lord knows exactly what to do, how to do it, and when to do it.** God is God. Allow Him to function as God in this way (Excerpts from the Ministry of the Word, vol. 29, no. 07, pp.133-151).
