The **three basic prayers** concerning God are related to the Divine Trinity; **“Your name be sanctified”** is related mainly to the **Father**; **“Your kingdom come,”** to the **Son**; and **“Your will be done,”** to the **Spirit**...We need to **learn to pray**... As soon as we open our mouth to pray, we often mention our work, livelihood, or children—all matters related to our own needs. Instead, we need to practice the prayer that the Lord taught.

First, we need to **pray for the name of our Father who is in the heavens to be sanctified**. We need to pray for the Father’s name...to be separated from all that is common. Why should we pray that...? **This is because there are false gods everywhere on the earth**, and many even consider our God to be a false god. We need to pray for the name of the only true God in the universe to be sanctified, to be separated from all the names of the false gods, **so that His name would be exalted**...For the name of the Father to be sanctified, we must first see whether the name of the Father is **sanctified in us, whether our living expresses Him, and whether people, upon seeing our living, feel that the name of the Father is sanctified in us**. We should desire to live Him among our co-workers, neighbors, and friends. Although we live among all men and love everyone, we are separated from among them; **as soon as people see us**, they should know that we are of God and that the name of the Father is sanctified in us.

The second basic prayer concerning God is, **“Your kingdom come.”** Today the world is Satan’s kingdom, full of sorrow and fear. People in the world get angry and complain whenever they watch the news. Why? It is because the kingdoms of the earth today are the kingdom of Satan. Romans 14:17 indicates that the kingdom of God has three outstanding characteristics: righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. None of the countries in the world have joy. Why is there **no joy**? It is because there is **no peace**; instead, there is strife everywhere. Why is there **no peace**? It is because there is **no righteousness**. Therefore, we need to pray to God for His kingdom to come and for His righteousness to be fully established on earth...

The third basic prayer concerning God is, **“Your will be done on earth.”** Throughout the ages, many wicked people and dictators have done Satan’s will. But history tells us that in the end they were all destroyed. **The will of God will not be hindered, but it still needs our cooperating prayers**; if we can bring the heavenly rule to earth by prayer, the will of God will be done perfectly on earth. This is being fulfilled in this age, and it will be ultimately fulfilled in the kingdom age when the name of God will be excellent in all the earth, the kingdom of the world will become the kingdom of Christ, and the will of God will be accomplished (Psa. 8:1 ; Rev. 11:15). **We all need to have this faith...**

**May the Lord increase our prayer life more and more.** When we see that our country, city, or community has sufferings, chaos, and all kinds of negative situations, we all need to pray...For the church to go on, we can also practice praying, “Our Father who is in the heavens, may Your name be sanctified in the church where we are. May Your kingdom, Your heavenly rule, come unto our church.”

As we become more deeply involved in the church life, we may find that there are **disputes** and **negative talk** among brothers and sisters. Their **emphasis on what is right and what is wrong spreads death**, because these things are out of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. When we encounter these things, we need to pray, “Father, may Your name be sanctified in the church; may Your name be all that is discussed, exalted, and spoken. May Your kingdom come to the church. Lord, **Your heavenly rule must rule our church life. Lord, may Your life rule over everything; may the principles of the tree of life swallow up all the principles of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Lord, may Your will be done in the church.**” When we are **in disharmony and unhappy** with others, we should also pray, “Father, may Your name be sanctified in my relationship with others; may my relationship with others be preserved under the rule of the kingdom by having righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. Lord, for this reason, should I go to apologize to someone? May Your will be done in me.” **We all need to practice this.** Of course, this is not a legal requirement, but this is indeed a very important principle of the kingdom life (Excerpts from The Ministry of the Word, vol. 29, no. 10, pp.53-66).

## PRAYER BURDENS:

1. Make us a man of prayer – not just a common man praying common prayers but praying in the divine and mystical realm. Keep us in the presence of God closely and continually where the ruler of this world has nothing.
2. Remind us to pray in this way and take Your pattern of prayer to sanctify the Father’s name, to bring in Your kingdom, and for Your will to be done. Uplift our prayers not for things related to our personal lives, but to Your kingdom.
3. Lord, we simply trust in You that You would provide “today” our “daily bread”. We live not on what we have stored, but on Your supply. Save us from being confident in ourselves and cause us to see our weaknesses.

5. Cause our prayers to bring us into God. We realize that we can do nothing and that we seek for the supply of the Holy Spirit – the loaves, the fish, and the eggs. Feed us as we remain in You that we can also feed others.
6. We return to You with all our hearts so You can direct our prayers to the Holy Land, the holy city, and the holy temple. Make us desperate to aim our prayers at Your interests on earth for Your eternal economy.
