THE SECOND STAGE – ABIDING IN CHRIST Knowing the Will of God

*When we touch the Lord in fellowship, we thereby have **an inward feeling**... The problem is that **we do not believe** what we feel. We usually **over-analyze** the feeling, fearing it is either not from God or a wrong feeling. Often our fear is not that we may be wrong and sin against God, but that the outcome may not be to our advantage. Such a fear proves that we are considering **our own gain or loss**. If so, it makes it **difficult** for us to understand **God's** will. Therefore, each time we touch a feeling from our fellowship with God, as long as it is not in obvious conflict with the teaching of the Bible, we should believe and accept it as from God. Even though, due to our childish condition, we sometimes accept the feeling wrongly, we still have to believe that we are wrong in the hand of God, and **God will still keep us**. Although we may be wrong in a certain affair, yet our being and our spirit are still right, and **God is still pleased with us**...*

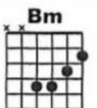
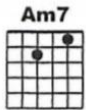
