### Scripture Readings:

**Heb. 5:9** And having been perfected, He became to all those who obey Him [the source of eternal salvation](#),

**Heb. 5:10** Being addressed by God as [a High Priest](#) according to the order of Melchizedek;

**Heb. 6:1** Therefore leaving the word of the beginning of Christ, let us be brought on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith in God,

**Heb. 6:4** For it is impossible for those who have once been enlightened and have tasted of the heavenly gift and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit

**Heb. 6:5** And have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come,

**Heb. 6:6** And yet have fallen away, to renew themselves again unto repentance, crucifying again for themselves the Son of God and putting Him to open shame.

**Heb. 6:7** For the earth, which drinks the rain which often comes upon it and produces vegetation suitable to those for whose sake also it is cultivated, partakes of blessing from God.

**Heb. 6:8** But if it brings forth thorns and thistles, it is disapproved and near a curse, whose end is to be burned.

**Heb. 8:10** For this is the covenant which I will covenant with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will impart My laws into their mind, and on their hearts I will inscribe them; and I will be God to them, and they will be a people to Me.

**Heb. 8:11** And they shall by no means each teach his fellow citizen and each his brother, saying, Know the Lord; for [all will know Me](#) from the little one to the great one among them.

**Heb. 9:14** How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

**Heb. 10:25** [Not abandoning our own assembling together](#), as the custom with some is, but [exhorting one another](#); and so much the more as you see the day drawing near.

**Heb. 10:26** For when we sin willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice of bulls and goats for sins,

**Heb. 10:27** But a certain fearful expectation of [judgment](#) and fervor of [fire](#), which is to consume the adversaries.

**Heb. 10:28** Anyone who has set aside the law of Moses dies without compassion on the testimony of two or three witnesses.

**Heb. 10:29** By how much do you think he will be thought worthy of worse punishment who has trampled underfoot the Son of God and has considered the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing and has [insulted the Spirit of grace](#)?

**Heb. 10:30** For we know Him who said, “Vengeance is Mine; I will repay”; and again, “[The Lord will judge His people.](#)”

**Heb. 10:31** It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

**Heb. 12:1** Therefore let us also, having so great [a cloud of witnesses](#) surrounding us, [put away](#) every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us and [run with endurance the race](#) which is set before us,

**Heb. 12:2** [Looking away unto Jesus](#), the [Author](#) and [Perfecter](#) of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down on the right hand of the throne of God.

**Heb. 12:25** See that you do not refuse Him who speaks, for if those did not escape who refused Him who warned them upon the earth, much more we shall not escape who turn away from Him who warns from heaven,

**Heb. 12:28** Therefore [receiving an unshakable kingdom](#), let us have grace, through which we may serve God well-pleasingly with piety and fear;

**Heb. 12:29** For our God is also [a consuming fire](#).
