6 - The Word of Life

♣ GOD BREATHED (2 Tim 3:16):

- 1 John 1:1 "That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we beheld, and our hands handled concerning the **Word of life**."
- John 1:1 "In the beginning was the **Word**, and the **Word** was with God, and the **Word** was God."
- John 1:4 "In Him was life, and the life was the light of men."
- John 1:14 "And the Word became flesh and tabernacled among us (and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only Begotten from the Father), full of grace and reality."

↓ THE EXCELLENCY OF THE KNOWLEDGE OF CHRIST (Phil. 3:8):

In the Godhead Christ is the Word of Life.

- > The **Word** conveys the eternal life
 - In this Word was life,
 - In this life was the light of men
- The Word is the divine person of Christ
 - Who was with God and is God in eternity before creation
 - Who became flesh in time
 - In whom is life, and He is life.
- The Word became flesh (John 1:14)
 - and tabernacled among us,
 - o this tabernacle means that the Word became a man
 - this tabernacle becomes a mutual abode, in which both God and we may abide
 - full of grace and truth
 - o in this tabernacle we enjoy grace
 - in this tabernacle we receive the reality
 - and having the glory as of an only begotten from a father.
 - o in this tabernacle we see the glory
- > The **Word** is the very God.
 - As an account, a definition of God
 - The expression of all that God is
- The phrase "the Word of life" in Greek indicates that the Word is life.

♣ SPEAK TO THE PEOPLE ALL THE WORDS OF THIS LIFE (Act 5:20):

- ♣ This **Word**, who is the eternal life, became a man as a mutual dwelling place of God and us.
- ♣ In this **dwelling place** we enjoy Him as grace, we see Him as our reality, and we behold His glory.
- **♣** The "*the Word of life*" actually indicates that the Word is life—God's expression.
