↓ IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD (John 1:1)

- Luke 2:11 Because today a Savior has been born to you in David's city, who is Christ the Lord.
- John 4:42 And they said to the woman, It is no longer because of your speaking *that* we believe, for we ourselves have heard and know that this One is truly the Savior of the world.
- Isa. 40:3 The voice of one who cries In the wilderness: Make clear The way of Jehovah; Make straight in the desert A highway for our God.
- Luke 3:4 As it is written in the book of the words of Isaiah the prophet, "A voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare the way of the Lord; make straight His paths.
- Luke 3:5 Every ravine shall be filled up, and every mountain and hill shall be leveled; and the crooked *places* shall become a straight *way*, and the rough ways smooth.
- Luke 3:6 And all flesh shall see the salvation of God."
- Luke 19:9 And Jesus said to him, Today salvation has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham.

Salvation, is the application of the redemption accomplished by Christ on the cross.

! In salvation Christ is the **Savior**.

- ➤ He is the Savior in order to save us.
 - "A Savior was born ... Christ the Lord." (Luke 2:11)
 - The Lord Jesus is the Savior of the world (John 4:42)
- ➤ He is the Savior of fallen mankind based upon His person and His redemptive work.
- ➤ He is the very God becoming a man to be our Savior.

♦ Christ is Salvation of God to all flesh (Luke 3:4-6)

- ➤ He is the salvation God prepared for us.
- > Apart from Him there is no salvation.
- If we receive Him, we receive salvation immediately.
- The Lord Jesus said..., "Today salvation has come to this house" (Luke 19:9).

↓ WITH ONE ACCORD ... WITH ONE MOUTH GLORIFY THE GOD (Rom. 15:6)

- 4 He has accomplished full redemption for us the sinners, through which He may save us from God's condemnation and from our fallen condition. What He is and what He has accomplished make Him competent to be the able Savior to save us to the uttermost from all our problems.
