✚ IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD (John 1:1)

- Luke 2:11 - Because today a **Savior has been born** to you in David's city, who is Christ the Lord.
- John 4:42 - And they said to the woman, It is no longer because of your speaking *that* we believe, for we ourselves have heard and know that this One is truly the **Savior of the world**.
- Isa. 40:3 - The voice of one who cries In the wilderness: **Make clear The way** of Jehovah; Make straight in the desert A highway for our God.
- Luke 3:4 - As it is written in the book of the words of Isaiah the prophet, “A voice of one crying in the wilderness, **Prepare the way of the Lord**; make straight His paths.
- Luke 3:5 - Every ravine shall be filled up, and every mountain and hill shall be leveled; and the crooked *places* shall become a straight *way*, and the rough ways smooth.
- Luke 3:6 - And all flesh shall **see the salvation of God**.”
- Luke 19:9 - And Jesus said to him, **Today salvation has come** to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham.

✚ LET US OFFER UP A SACRIFICE OF PRAISE CONTINUALLY TO GOD (Heb. 13:15)

Redemption is what Christ **accomplished** on the cross.

Salvation, is the **application** of the redemption accomplished by Christ on the cross.

❖ In salvation Christ is the **Savior**.

- He is the **Savior** in order to save us.
 - “A **Savior** was born ... *Christ the Lord*.” (Luke 2:11)
 - The Lord Jesus is the **Savior** of the world (John 4:42)
- He is the **Savior** of fallen mankind **based** upon His **person** and His **redemptive** work.
- He is the very God becoming a man to be our **Savior**.

❖ Christ is **Salvation** of God to all flesh (Luke 3:4-6)

- He is the **salvation** God prepared for us.
- **Apart** from Him there is no **salvation**.
- **If** we **receive** Him, we receive **salvation** immediately.
- The Lord Jesus said..., “**Today salvation** has come to this house” (Luke 19:9).

✚ WITH ONE ACCORD ... WITH ONE MOUTH GLORIFY THE GOD (Rom. 15:6)

- ✚ He has **accomplished** full redemption for us the sinners, **through** which He may save us from God's condemnation and from our fallen condition. What He is and what He has accomplished make Him competent to be the able **Savior** to save us to the uttermost from all our problems.
- ✚ **Isaiah 40:3** prophesied that John the Baptist was coming to **prepare** the way for Christ so that He may come to be the **salvation** of God to all flesh. Christ is the **Savior**. He is the **salvation** God prepared for us.
