#### **↓ IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD (John 1:1)**

- John 12:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, Unless the grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it abides alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.
- **1Pet. 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has regenerated us unto a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

### Christ has a reproduction,

- ➤ He is the grain of wheat (John12:24).
  - The Lord Jesus, as a **grain of wheat**, fall into the ground and die
    - o in order to produce many grains as His reproduction
    - o through His death and resurrection He has produced the church as His reproduction
- He has regenerated us unto a living hope through the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 1:3).
  - when Christ was resurrected, we, His believers, were all included in Him
  - when Christ was resurrected, we were resurrected with Him (Eph. 2:6)

#### **♣ WITH ONE ACCORD ... WITH ONE MOUTH GLORIFY THE GOD (Rom. 15:6)**

- **↓ In His resurrection** Christ imparted the divine life into us and made us the same as He is in life and nature to be His reproduction.
- **Through** His **death and resurrection** He has been multiplied and propagated. This propagation is for the producing of the church. Through His death and resurrection He has produced the church as His reproduction.
