5. A Resurrected Man with a Spiritual Body of Flesh and Bones

↓ IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD (John 1:1)

- John 20:19 When therefore it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and while the doors were shut where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, **Jesus came** and stood in the midst and said to them, Peace be to you.
- Luke 24:36 And as they were speaking these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them, Peace to you.
- Luke 24:37 But they were terrified and became frightened and thought they beheld a spirit.
- Luke 24:38 And He said to them, Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your heart?
- Luke 24:39 See My hands and My feet, that *it* is I Myself. Touch Me and see, for a **spirit** does not have flesh and bones as you behold Me having.
- Luke 24:40 And when He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet.
- Luke 24:42 And they handed Him a piece of broiled fish;
- Luke 24:43 And He took it and ate before them.
- 1Cor 15:44 It is sown a soulish body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a soulish body, there is also a spiritual one.

LET US OFFER UP A SACRIFICE OF PRAISE CONTINUALLY TO GOD (Heb. 13:15)

Christ in resurrection is a resurrected man with a spiritual body of flesh and bones.

- ➤ On the day of His resurrection Christ came back to the disciples with a resurrected body, (John 20:19).
 - He has a **spiritual body**, yet the body is physical.
 - o the Lord appeared with a physical body
 - o the resurrected Christ flesh and bones have become spiritual
 - He has a spiritual body, a resurrected body saturated by the spirit,
 - o a body in which the spirit predominates
 - o yet it was a body with flesh and bones
- ➤ He came into the room as the **Spirit**, yet with a physical, touchable body. (Luke 24:36-43)
 - The prints of the nails could still be seen.
 - The place in His side that had been pierced with a spear could still be seen and touched.
 - The Lord's body was visible and touchable, and He was able to eat food.

♣ WITH ONE ACCORD ... WITH ONE MOUTH GLORIFY THE GOD (Rom. 15:6)

- Christ in resurrection is a resurrected man with a spiritual body of flesh and bones. He has a spiritual body, yet the body is physical He appeared with a physical body.
 - "It is sown a soulish body, it is raised a spiritual body. If there is a soulish body, there is also a spiritual body."
 - ✓ A **soulish body** is a natural body animated by the soul, a body in which the soul predominates.
 - ✓ A **spiritual body** is a resurrected body saturated by the spirit, a body in which the spirit predominates.
