↓ IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD (John 1:1)

- Phil. 2:9 Therefore also God highly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name,

↓ LET US OFFER UP A SACRIFICE OF PRAISE CONTINUALLY TO GOD (Heb. 13:15)

- In ascension Christ is the God-exalted One, the One who has received the name which is above every name.
 - > Christ humbled Himself to the uttermost, but God exalted Him to the highest peak.
 - God has exalted Jesus to be the Lord of all.
 - By His exaltation the **Lord** has been given a name which is above every name.
 - there has never been a name in history higher than the name of the **Lord Jesus**.
 - o the highest name in the universe, the greatest name, is the name of Jesus.
 - o "in the name" mean in the sphere and element of all the Lord is.
 - We need to confess the Lord's name openly (Acts 2:21; Rom. 10:13).
 - we are to call "O Lord Jesus."
 - Our confessing that **Jesus is Lord** results in the glory of **God the Father**.

❖ In ascension Christ is the Righteous (1 John 2:1b)

- Our **Lord Jesus** is the only righteous man among all men.
 - Only He is qualified to be our **Advocate**
 - o to care for us in our sinning condition and
 - o to restore us to a righteous condition so that our **Father**, who is righteous, may be appeared.
- > Christ was the righteous One in His earthly life, for He was right with God and man.
 - Now, in the heavens, He is still the righteous One.
 - As the ascended One in the heavens, Christ does everything in a righteous way.
 - He is working and ministering righteously.
 - He intercede for us and to minister life to us righteously.
 - His heavenly ministry of life today is a ministry in righteousness.

♣ WITH ONE ACCORD ... WITH ONE MOUTH GLORIFY THE GOD (Rom. 15:6)

- The day is coming when those on every level: heaven, earth, and under the earth will bow their knees and confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. The Lord Jesus as a man was made the Lord in His ascension by God. Thus, every tongue should confess that He is Lord. Our confessing that Jesus is Lord results in the glory of God the Father.
