↓ IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD (John 1:1)

- Matt. 26:64 Jesus said to him, You have said *rightly*. Nevertheless I say to you, From now on you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of Power and coming on the clouds of heaven.
- Rev.14:14 And I saw, and behold, *there was* a white cloud, and on the cloud One like the Son of Man sitting, having a golden crown on His head and a sharp sickle in His hand..
- Matt. 24:27 For just as the lightning comes forth from the east and shines to the west, so will the coming of the Son of Man be.
- Matt. 24:30 And at that time the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the land will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- Rev. 22:16 I Jesus have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the bright morning star.

LET US OFFER UP A SACRIFICE OF PRAISE CONTINUALLY TO GOD (Heb. 13:15)

❖ In His coming back Christ will **still** be the Son of Man (Matt. 26:64).

- In the heavens today the Lord is the Son of Man
- ➤ He will be the Son of Man even at His coming back on the clouds.
- When the Lord comes back to reap His harvest on the earth (Rev. 14:15), He still will be the Son of Man.
 - At that time He will be sitting on the cloud, clothed with a cloud (Rev. 10:1).
 - It refers to the open aspect of Christ's coming back toward the Jews and Gentiles (1Thes. 4:17; Matt. 24:27)
 - o As the lightning comes forth from the east and shines to the west so will be the coming of **Christ** (Matt. 24:27)
 - Lightning is concealed in a cloud, waiting for the opportunity to flash forth, as **Christ** will also be clothed with a cloud then will suddenly appear like a flash to the earth.

❖ In His coming back Christ will be the morning star to the overcomers (Rev. 22:16).

- At Christ's first appearing the wise men, saw **His** star (Matt. 2:2, 9-10).
- At His second appearing He will be the morning star, secret aspect of His coming back
 - As a reward to His overcomers who watch and wait for His coming
- > The **Lord Jesus** is the Root and the Offspring of David, the bright morning star (Rev. 22:16)
 - Christ as the Root and Offspring of David is related to Israel and the kingdom,
 - His being the bright morning star is related to the **church** and the rapture.

WITH ONE ACCORD ... WITH ONE MOUTH GLORIFY THE GOD (Rom. 15:6)

- ♣ The Lord will come back as the Son of Man.
 - ✓ When He came the first time, He came to be a man through incarnation.
 - ✓ When He died on the cross, He was crucified as a man.
 - ✓ When He was resurrected. He was resurrected as a man.
 - ✓ When He ascended, He ascended as a man, and He is now in the heavens as a man.
 - ✓ When He comes back, He will still be the Son of Man.
- The Son of Man is the morning star that will appears before the darkest hour, the great tribulation, after which the day of the kingdom will dawn. In the kingdom the Lord will appear publicly to His people as the sun, but before the great tribulation He will appear privately to His overcomers as the morning star.
