❖ In the New Jerusalem **Christ** will still be the **Son of Man eternally** (John 1:51).

- ➤ In eternity past He was God,
 - solely and merely divine, having no humanity
- In eternity future He will be God and man,
 - both divine and human, having divinity as well as humanity
 - He will have two natures, two essences, and two substances—divinity and humanity.
 - Christ will be not only God but also man, not only the Son of God but also the Son of Man.

❖ In eternity **Christ**, He will also be the **Shepherd eternally** (Rev. 7:17)

- As our Shepherd, Christ, will feed us—(dispensing Himself into us)
 - In eternity we shall not have problems,
 - but we shall still need Christ's eternal shepherding

↓ "FOR YOU CAN ALL PROPHESY ONE BY ONE ..." (1 Cor. 14:31)

- **Eternally** Christ will be the **Son** of **Man** to be the Lamb, the Husband, the temple, the lamp, the spring of water of life, and the tree of life. He will have both divinity and humanity forever.
