✚ “...the words which I have spoken to you are **spirit** and are **life**” (John 6:63)

BETRAYED

[Prophecy]

- Psa. 41:9 - Even my familiar friend, in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, has **lifted** his heel **against me**.
Zech. 11:12 - And I said to them, If it is good in your sight, give me my wages; but if not, do not bother.
So they weighed out my wages, **thirty pieces of silver**.

[Fulfillment]

- John 13:18 - I do not speak concerning all of you. I know whom I have chosen, but that the Scripture may be **fulfilled**,
“*He who eats bread with Me has lifted up his heel against Me.*”
Mark 14:18 - And as they were reclining *at table* and eating, Jesus said,
Truly I say to you that one of you will **betray** Me, one who is eating with Me.
Matt. 26:15 - And said, What are you willing to give me, and I will deliver Him to you?
And they weighed out to him **thirty pieces of silver**.

SMITTEN

[Prophecy]

- Zech. 13:7 - Awake, O sword, against My **Shepherd**, And against the man who is My Fellow, Declares Jehovah of hosts.
Strike the Shepherd, That the sheep may be scattered; And I will turn My hand upon the little ones.

[Fulfillment]

- Matt. 26:31 - Then Jesus said to them, You will all be stumbled because of Me this night, for it is **written**,
“*I will **smite** the Shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.*”

✚ “...to **reveal** His Son in me...” (Gal. 1:16a)

❖ Christ is the one **betrayed** by his friend who **sold** him for thirty pieces of silver.

- This was **prophesied** in Psalms 41:9 and Zechariah 11:12
- And then it was **fulfilled** in John 13:18 at the time the Lord Jesus washed His disciples’ feet.
 - referring to the **betrayal** of the **Lord** by Judas
- The Lord in Mark 14:18, spoke of being **betrayed**, as He and the disciples were eating of the Passover feast
 - as a slave the Lord was **sold** for **thirty pieces of silver**

❖ Christ was the **smitten** Shepherd

- Zechariah 13:7 **prophesied** concerning Christ as the **smitten** shepherd:
 - “... **smite** the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered.”
- The **fulfillment** of Zechariah 13:7 is found in **Matthew 26:31**:
 - when Christ came as a man to be the **Shepherd**, He was **rejected**, **betrayed**, and **sold**
 - not only was He rejected and betrayed by men, but He was even **smitten** by God
 - the **Lord** was the **Shepherd**, and the disciples were the **sheep** who were to be scattered
 - all the disciples said that they would not deny Him, eventually, what they did was the reverse

✚ “...let all the peoples **speak praise** to Him ...” (Rom. 15:11)

✚ According to Exodus 21:32, a **slave** was priced at thirty pieces of silver. **Christ** was **priced** as a slave, and **Judas betrayed** Him for this price, **selling** Him for thirty pieces of silver. Christ is the one **betrayed**, **sold** for thirty pieces of silver, and was killed on the cross for our redemption.

✚ When **Christ** came as a man to be the **Shepherd**, He was **rejected**, **betrayed**, and **sold** for thirty pieces of silver. However, not only was He rejected and betrayed by men, but He was even **smitten** by God. Christ was sold for thirty pieces of silver by men, but following that He was smitten on the **cross** by God Himself.
