## BEING SLAUGHTER

#### [Prophecy]

Isa. 53:7 - He was oppressed, and it was He who was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth;
Like a lamb that is led to the slaughter And like a sheep that is dumb before its shearers,
So He did not open His mouth.

#### [Fulfillment]

Matt. 26:62 - And the high priest stood up and said to Him, Do You answer nothing? What *is it that* these testify against You?

Matt. 26:63 - But Jesus remained silent...

## **EXECUTED and MADE INTERCESSOR**

#### [Prophesy]

Isa. 53:9 - And they assigned His grave with the wicked,

Isa. 53:12 - Therefore I will divide to Him a portion with the Great, And He will divide the spoil with the Strong; Because He poured out His life unto death And was numbered with the transgressors, Yet He alone bore the sin of many And interceded for the transgressors.

### [Fulfillment]

Luke 23:32 - And two others also, who were criminals, were led with Him to be executed.

Luke 23:33 - And when they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and one on the left.

Luk3 23:34 - And Jesus said, **Father**, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing. And dividing His garments, they cast lots.

## **4** "...to reveal His Son in me..." (Gal. 1:16a)

- The **Lord Jesus** as a lamb was brought to the slaughter and as a sheep dumb before its shearers
  - The **Lord**, standing before the Sanhedrin like a sheep before its shearers, would not say a word to vindicate Himself, fulfilling the prophecy in Isaiah 53:7.
    - He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth
    - He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb
    - He answered nothing, Jesus remained silent–Matt. 26:62-63
- ❖ The **Lord Jesus** is the One who was executed with two criminals
  - ➤ Isaiah 53:9a and 12c tells us that
    - "he was numbered with the transgressors,"
    - "he made his grave with the wicked"
  - As the fulfillment of the prophecy in Isaiah 53, Luke 23:32 and 33 say,
    - "Two others also, who were criminals, were led with Him to be executed.
    - And when they came to the place called Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals..."
    - Christ was executed with two criminals, this was done under God's sovereignty
      - o that the prophecy of Isaiah concerning Christ's execution might be fulfilled
- The **Lord Jesus** was the One who made intercession for the transgressors
  - ➤ In Isaiah 53:12 it is prophesied that Christ would make "intercession for the transgressors."

- To fulfill this prophecy, Jesus said, in Luke 23:34 -
  - "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing."

## **4** "...let all the peoples speak praise to Him ..." (Rom. 15:11)

- The Lord Jesus was oppressed, and He was afflicted, He was brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers did not open His mouth. The Lord, standing did not say a word to vindicate Himself.
- The Lord Jesus was executed with two criminals, He was numbered with the transgressors, and He was considered a criminal but while He was on the cross the Lord made intercession for the transgressors. He interceded for us that we would be forgiven by God.
