[Prophecy]

Psa. 2:7 - I will recount the decree of Jehovah; He said to Me: You are My Son; Today I have begotten You.

2Sam. 7:14 - I will be his Father, and he will be My son...;

[Fulfillment]

Heb. 1:5 - For to which of the angels has He ever said, "You are My Son; this day have I begotten You"? And again, "I will be a Father to Him, and He will be a Son to Me"?

"...to reveal His Son in me..." (Gal. 1:16a)

- ❖ Christ is the one who was begotten the Firstborn son of God and whose Father God became
 - > Psalms 2:7 is a prophesies –

"You are My Son; Today I have begotten You"

"I will be his Father, and he will be My son"

- Christ being the One who was begotten the firstborn Son of God
- God became His Father (2 Samuel 7:14)
- ➤ Both verses are quoted / fulfilled in Hebrews 1:5:
 - "For to which of the angels has He ever said, You are My Son; this day I have begotten You?
 - And again, I will be to Him a Father, and He shall be to Me a Son?"

4 "...let all the peoples speak praise to Him ..." (Rom. 15:11)

- ↓ Through resurrection **Christ** in **His** humanity was born **to be** the firstborn **Son** of **God**. The Lord Jesus was born of a virgin to be the Son of Man, **yet** He still needed to be born of the **Father** to be the firstborn **Son** of **God**. When He was born in this way, His humanity was "*sonized*" through resurrection.
 - God is a Father of Christ in two senses:
 - ✓ first, in the sense that God was the Father of Christ in His divinity from eternity;
 - ✓ second, in the sense that God is the Father of Christ in His humanity in resurrection through which Christ was begotten to be the firstborn Son of God.
