[Prophecy]

Isa. 53:11 - He will see the fruit of the travail of His soul, And He will be satisfied; By the knowledge of Him, the **righteous** One, My **Servant**, will make the many **righteous**, And He will bear their iniquities.

[Fulfillment]

Acts 13:39 - And from all the things from which you were not able to be justified by the law of Moses, in this One everyone who believes is justified.

Rom. 4:25 - Who was delivered for our offenses and was raised for our justification.

4 "...to reveal His Son in me..." (Gal. 1:16a)

- **Christ** the resurrected, righteous servant of Jehovah through whom many would be justified
 - ➤ Isaiah 53:11b says, "By his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many."
 - This prophecy indicates that **Christ** is the resurrected, righteous Servant of Jehovah through whom many are justified.
 - It is through the resurrected Christ that the believers are justified by God.
 - ➤ Isaiah 53:11b is fulfilled in Acts 13:39 and Romans 4:25.
 - Acts 13:39 says, "From all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses, in this One everyone who believes is justified."
 - o This is the **One** who has been resurrected to be God's **firstborn Son**, our Savior, and the many holy and trustworthy things (Acts 13:33-34).
 - Through the **One** who is the holy and trustworthy things as God's mercies to us we are justified from all the things.
 - o Furthermore, the **One** through whom we are justified is Himself our justification.
 - **Justification** is a mercy from God to us,
 - and this **mercy** is an aspect of the resurrected Christ.
 - Today Christ in resurrection is our justification.

"...let all the peoples speak praise to Him ..." (Rom. 15:11)

- The resurrection of **Christ** is a proof of our justification by God. The death of Christ fully satisfied God's righteous requirements so that we may be justified by God through Christ's death (Rom. 3:24). **In Him**, we are accepted by God, He is also in us to live for us a life that can be justified by God and is always acceptable to God.
- **←** Christ is not in the tomb. God raised Him up from the dead, and He came back in resurrection. This is a strong proof that God has accepted His death for us that His death satisfied God's requirements and fulfilled whatever God wanted Him to do for us. The resurrection of Christ is the proof of our justification by God. **In Him**, the resurrected One, we are justified.
