39. CHRIST IN HIS PERSON (19) – In the Fulfillment of the OT Prophecies

N 57. The Resurrected Christ **Seated** at the Right Hand of Jehovah

4 "...the words which I have spoken to you are spirit and are life" (John 6:63)

[Prophecy]

Psa. 110:1 - Jehovah declares to my Lord, Sit at My right hand Until I make Your enemies Your footstool.

[Fulfillment]

- Acts 2:33 Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God and having received the promise of the Holy Spirit from the Father, He has poured out this which you both see and hear.
- [Acts 2:34-35 For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand Until I set Your enemies as a footstool for Your feet."]
- Heb. 1:3 ..., having made purification of sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

4 "...to reveal His Son in me..." (Gal. 1:16a)

The resurrected **Christ** seated at the right hand of **Jehovah**

- ➤ In Psalm 110:1 we have a prophecy regarding the resurrected Christ seated at the right hand of Jehovah.
- In its fulfillment, Acts 2:33-35 referred to the resurrected Christ as sitting at the right hand of God.
 - It was from the time of His ascension that God exalted Him to sit at His right hand (Heb. 1:3).
 - The Lord said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand, until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your feet."
 - o The first "Lord" refers to God, and
 - o the second, to Christ, whom David called "my Lord" (Matt. 22:44-45).
 - o The Lord Jesus sitting at God's right hand denotes the position of glory, honor, and power.
 - The exalted Christ receiving of the promise of the Holy Spirit was actually His receiving of the Holy Spirit Himself (Acts 2:33).
 - o Christ was conceived of the Spirit essentially for His existence in humanity,
 - and was anointed with the Spirit economically for His ministry among men.
 - After His resurrection and ascension, He still needed to receive the Spirit economically again that He might pour Himself out upon His **Body**.

4 "...let all the peoples speak praise to Him ..." (Rom. 15:11)

♣ Christ, having made purification of sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high. He has been exalted to the right hand of God and received the promise of the Holy Spirit Himself. He poured Himself out upon His Body to carry out His heavenly ministry on earth for the accomplishing of God's New Testament economy.
