### In the Fulfillment of the Types and Figures of the Old Testament

#### O 5. The Ark

## # "...the words which I have spoken to you are spirit and are life," (John 6:63b)

#### [Type/Figure

- Gen. 6:14 [God said to Noah...] Make yourself an ark of gopher wood; ... and shall cover it within and without with pitch.
- Gen. 6:16 ... you shall put the entrance of the ark in its side; you shall make it with lower, second, and third stories.

#### [Fulfillment]

- 1Pet. 3:20 ...God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared; *entering* into which...were brought safely through by water.
- 1Pet. 3:21 Which *water*, as the antitype, also now saves you, *that is*, baptism, not a putting away of the filth of the flesh but the appeal of a good conscience unto God, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,

## **4** "...to come to the full knowledge of the truth...." (1Tim.2:4b)

- The ark made by Noah and into which he and his family entered is a type of Christ (Genesis 6:14-16).
  - The ark's three stories signify the Triune God; a type of the Three of the Godhead
    - the ark had three stories, that it was made of gopher wood,
      - The ark was made of gopher wood, which is a cypress full of resin that can withstand the attack of water.
      - o Cypress signifies the **crucified Christ**, who can withstand the waters of death.
    - The ark was pitched within and without with pitch (Gen. 6:14).
      - o The Hebrew for "pitch" has the same root as the Hebrew word for atonement, meaning to cover.
      - o Only in Christ, who fulfills the type of the ark, can we have the full covering in His redemption.
      - Noah and his family could not have been saved outside of the ark. Only by entering into Christ can we be saved (Genesis 7:13).
  - ➤ Hebrews 2:9, Christ tasted death "on behalf of everything."
    - Christ's redemption was accomplished not only for mankind but for everything created by God.
  - ➤ Colossians 1:20 says that God has reconciled all things to Himself through Christ.
    - This is clearly typified by the redemption of Noah's ark, in which not only eight persons but also the living things created by God were saved.
    - The fact that creatures as well as human beings were in the **ark** indicates that Christ accomplished an all-inclusive death for every creature.

### **4** "...Pursue love, and desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy." (1Cor. 14:1)

- The Triune God is in Christ, mingled with human nature typified by the wood of gopher, which is a cypress full of resin. This resinous wood can withstand the attack of water. Cypress signifies the crucified Christ, who can withstand the waters of death. He tasted death, and death could not damage Him. Christ is the real gopher wood.
- The ark made by Noah was pitched within and without with pitch, meaning to cover. Christ is our full covering in His redemption. We were saved by entering into the ark of Noah a type of our entering into Christ. Only by entering into Christ can we be saved.
