4 "In my heart I have treasured up Your word..." (Psa. 119:11)

[Type/Figure – David]

1Sam. 16:13 - ... Samuel ... anointed him [David]..., and the Spirit of Jehovah rushed upon David ...

[Fulfillment – Christ the real Joshua]

- Heb. 1:9 ...; therefore God, Your God, has anointed You [Christ] with the oil of exultant joy...";
- Rev. 5:5 ...; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome
- Rom. 1:3 Concerning His Son, who came out of the seed of David according to the flesh,
- Matt. 1:1 The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham:

+ "...For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of Jehovah, ..." (Isa. 11:9)

- Christ is the greater David.
 - **King David, God's anointed, and his followers were rejected by the people.**
 - David and his followers were hungry.
 - They entered into the house of God and ate the showbread,
 - o seemingly breaking the Levitical law (1Sam 21:1-9).
 - The coming of David changed the dispensation from the age of the priests to the age of the kings.
 - **Christ**, the real David, God's Anointed and His followers were rejected also.
 - Christ and His disciples also were hungry.
 - They went into the grainfield and pick ears of grain on the Sabbath
 - o seemingly against the sabbatical regulation (Matt. 12:3-4).
 - By the **coming** of **Christ**, the dispensation was also changed, from the age of the law to the age of grace.
 - > Christ is greater that all things and persons in the Old Testament that typify Him.
 - Christ is the Root of David (Rev. 5:5).
 - He is the seed of David (Rom. 1:3).
 - He is the Son of David (Matt. 1:1).
 - He is the real David.

4 "And having gift that differ..., let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;" (Rom. 12:6)

In Matt. 1:6 David is called "the king" because through him the kingdom with the kingship was brought in. As the real David, the greater David, Christ is such a One. As typified by David, Christ is the fighting King, who has won the victory over all enemies, who has gained the land, and who has prepared all the materials for building up the church as the temple of God.
