# P – 29. The Man Seeking the Lost Sheep

**♣** "So that what was spoken through the prophet [Psa. 78:2] might be fulfilled, saying, 'I will open My mouth in parables; I will utter things hidden from the foundation of the world'." (Matt 13:35)

[Parable – A **Shepherd** Seeking a Sheep]

- Luke 15:4 Which man of you, who has a hundred sheep and has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the one which is lost until he finds it?
- Luke 15:5 And when he finds *it*, he lays *it* on his shoulders, rejoicing.
- Luke 15:7 I tell you that in the same way there will be *more* joy in heaven over one sinner repenting than over ninety-nine righteous persons who have no need of repentance.
- **4** "...He taught them many things in parables... (Mark 4:2)
  - "...Why do You speak in parables to them? (Mat 13:10)
  - "...And His disciples came to Him, saying, Make the parable ... clear to us. (Matt. 13:36)
- **Christ** is portrayed as a man seeking the lost sheep (Matt. 3-7).
  - The shepherd going into the wilderness to seek the lost sheep
    - The **Son** has come into the world (wilderness) to be with men (John 1:14).
    - The **Son** came in His humanity as the **Shepherd** 
      - o to find the sinner as a lost sheep
      - o and bring it back home.
    - The Son was rejoicing having found the one that was lost.
      - He lays us on His shoulder
        - our Savior's saving strength and His saving love.
  - ➤ In God's salvation the One who comes, practically speaking, is the Son.
    - The **Son** comes to accomplish redemption, the foundation of our salvation.
    - The redemption accomplished by Christ's death on the cross is the base of God's salvation.
- 4 "And having the same spirit of faith according to that which is written, "I believed, therefore I spoke," we also believe, therefore we also speak," (2Cor. 4:13)
- ☐ In Luke 15:3-32 the Lord Jesus spoke three parables unveiling and depicting how the **divine Trinity** works to bring sinners back, **through** the **Son** and **by** the **Spirit**, **to** the **Father**. As the **Shepherd**, the Son's way to seek us out is to **die for us**. He is the good **Shepherd** who gives His life for the sheep (John 10:11). If He did not die for us, He would not have a way to seek us out. We thank and praise for the Shepherd's work dying for us.
- ♣ The Lord Jesus, our Shepherd has come into the world to be with us (John 1:14). He came in His humanity as the Shepherd to find us "lost sheep" and bring us back home. Having found us, His sheep -
  - ✓ "He lays us on His shoulders, rejoicing," and
  - ✓ "in the same way there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner repenting than over ninety-nine righteous persons who have no need of repentance."
