14. The Door to Leave the Fold

Your words were found and I ate them, And Your word became to me The gladness and joy of my heart," (Jer. 15:16)

- Gal. 3:23 But before faith came we were guarded under law, being shut up unto the faith which was to be revealed.
- Gal. 3:24 So then the law has become our child-conductor unto Christ that we might be justified out of faith.
- Gal. 3:25 But since faith has come, we are no longer under a child-conductor.
- Gal. 3:26 For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
- John 10:7 Jesus therefore said to them again, Truly, truly, I say to you that I am the door of the sheep.
- John 10:9 **I am** the **door**; if anyone enters through Me, he shall be saved and shall go in and go out and shall find pasture.

↓ "Until we all arrive at the oneness of the faith and of the full knowledge of the Son of God, ..." (Eph. 4:13)

- Christ is the door to leave the fold (<u>John 10:9</u>).
 - The fold in John 10 signifies the law and also Judaism, the religion of the law.
 - ✓ Before Christ came,
 - God put His chosen people under the custody of the law.
 - God prepared the law as the sheepfold to keep and confine His chosen people temporarily
 - The law was the fold where God's people as the sheep were kept and protected temporarily
 until the pasture, the permanent place for the sheep, was ready.
 - o However, the Jewish religion utilized the law to form Judaism, which then became the sheepfold.
 - ▶ John 10 reveals that Christ is the door through which we leave the fold and come to the pasture.
 - ✓ Christ has come, and the pasture is ready
 - Christ is the pasture, the permanent place for us to stay.
 - Let us come out of the law into Christ.
 - There is no need for us to be confined any longer in the custody of the Judaic law.
 - We are released from the fold of the law to enjoy the riches of the pasture.
 - Christ is the door through which we may come out of any kind of fold and come into Him as the pasture.

"But he who prophesies speaks building up and encouragement and consolation to men.," (1Cor. 14:3)

- The Lord is the door to the sheepfold. Originally, the fold was the law, and the Lord was the door into the law He is also the door for people to come out of the law.
 - ✓ Firstly, the **Old Testament** saints went into the fold, which was the law, through Christ as the door.
 - ✓ Now the **New Testament** believers are to come out of the law through Christ as the same door.
- **Christ** is the door, not only for God's elect to enter into the custody of the law in the Old Testament time before Christ came, but also, for us to come out of the fold of the law after Christ came. So, the Lord indicates that He is the door not only for God's chosen people to go in, but also for God's chosen people to go out.
