4 "Your words were found and I ate them, And Your word became to me The gladness and joy of my heart," (Jer. 15:16)

- John 10:3 ... the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.
- John 10:11 I am the good Shepherd; the good Shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.
- John 10:16 And I have other sheep, which are not of this fold;
 - I must lead them also, and they shall hear My voice, and there shall be one flock, one Shepherd.
- Ezk. 34:15 I Myself will shepherd My flock, and I will cause them to lie down, declares the Lord Jehovah.

╙ "Until we all arrive at the oneness of the faith and of the full knowledge of the Son of God, …" (Eph. 4:13)

- **Christ** is the good **Shepherd**.
 - > "the sheep hear his voice; and he calls his own sheep by name"
 - He leads them out of the fold (John 10:3)
 - He goes before the sheep, and they follow Him (v. 4)
 - He takes the sheep out of the fold through Himself as the door and to Himself as the pasture
 - "the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep" (John 10:11)
 - Christ laid down His *psuche* life, His human life, for the sheep
 - so that they may have the *zoe* life, the divine life, the eternal life.
 - o Now He shepherds us inwardly in the way of life,
 - o Inwardly we have Christ as our Shepherd, as a Shepherd of life and in life.
 - Christ lives in us.
 - we live in Him, by Him, with Him, and through Him.
 - > "there shall be one flock, one Shepherd"
 - As the believers' Shepherd, Christ forms them into one flock (John 10:16),
 - the one universal church, the one Body of Christ.
 - consisting of all the believers in Christ.
 - The Lord supplies His sheep with Himself as life
 - o so that there may be one flock and one Shepherd, one Body and one Head.
 - the one flock is the church.
 - enjoying Him as our life and life supply.

"But he who prophesies speaks building up and encouragement and consolation to men.," (1Cor. 14:3)

- When we live in the Lord, we are under His shepherding. As we are under Christ's shepherding, there will be a life consciousness within us and also an instruction, a guidance, in life. The life within us, will indicate that the Lord intends to lead us in a certain way. This life consciousness with its leading and instruction is an indication that we are under the Lord's shepherding.
- The real Shepherd is the living Christ. As our Shepherd, the Lord not only gives us life; He is life to us. The living of Christ within us is actually His living shepherding. Hence, the Lord Jesus shepherds us by being life to us and by living in us.

The Good Shepherd Experience of Christ— As the Shepherd

 That here I want to stay. [1Pet. 4:12-14]
- 4 Oh, Father thank You for Your Son. [Gal.1:16]
 He shares Your heart for us. [Psa. 25:14]
 That gladly He would bear us to
 The bosom of Your love. [Rom. 8:32]
 No greater Shepherd could there be,
 That He would not lose one! [John 17:12]
 And lead us all to dwell with You.
