4 "Your words were found and I ate them, And Your word became to me The gladness and joy of my heart," (Jer. 15:16)

- John 15:1 I am the true vine, and My Father is the husbandman.
- John 15:4 Abide in Me and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither *can* you unless you abide in Me.
- John 15:5 I am the vine; you are the branches. He who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit; for apart from Me you can do nothing.;

- **Christ** is the vine (John 15:1a)
 - ➤ "My Father is the husbandman", the source of life (John 15:1b)
 - God the Father is growing the vine, Christ, and all of us are branches in Christ
 - God the **Father**, is cultivating the vine, **Christ**, with its branches in Christ.
 - the branches of the vine and are good for nothing except to express the vine.
 - all that the vine is and has is expressed through the branches. Individually,
 - the branches are the regenerated ones. Corporately,
 - they are the church, the **Body of Christ**.
 - The branches, the believers in the Son, are for the expression of the Son with the Father.
 - As branches we are filled with Christ as life.
 - o for to be a branch in the vine means that Christ has become our life.
 - ➤ "Abide in Me and I in you" (John 15:4).
 - Our life and our enjoyment are to abide in the vine.
 - Our destiny as branches is to remain in the vine.
 - > "Apart from Me you can do nothing." (John 15:5)
 - A branch of a vine cannot live by itself, for it will wither and die apart from the vine.
 - The relationship between the branches and the vine portrays the relationship between us and the Lord.
 - We are nothing, we have nothing, and we can do nothing apart from Him.
 - What we are, what we have, and what we do must be in the Lord and by the Lord in us.

"But he who prophesies speaks building up and encouragement and consolation to men.," (1Cor. 14:3)

- The vine is everything to the branches. Whatever is in the vine is also in the branches. The vine Christ, is a great enjoyment for us, the branches. From the vine and through the vine we receive everything we need: life, nourishment, light, water. We need to abide in the vine and do everything by abiding in the vine.
- 4 Christ is also the abiding place. He tells us to abide in Him. Christ is our abiding place, our dwelling place, our home, and we need to be fully settled in Him.

If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

Joh 15:11 -

These things I have spoken to you that My joy may be in you and that your joy may be made full.
