36. The One **Magnified** in Them

✚ “... the **words** which I have spoken to you are **spirit** and are **life**,” (John 6:63)

Phil. 1:20 - According to my earnest expectation and **hope** that in nothing I will be put to **shame**, but with all boldness, as always, even now **Christ** will be **magnified** in my **body**, whether through **life** or through **death**.

1Cor. 6:19 - Or do you not know that your **body** is a temple of the **Holy Spirit** within you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

1Cor. 6:20 - For you have been **bought** with a **price**. So then **glorify** God in your **body**.

✚ “... it **pleased** God, who ... called me through His grace, To **reveal** His Son in me ...,” (Gal 1:15-16)

❖ **Christ** is the **One magnified** in us, in our **body** (Phil. 1:20).

- **Christ** is vast, extensive, and **immeasurable** (Eph. 3:18)
 - He is **immeasurable**, for they are the dimensions of the universe
 - **but Christ** who **lives** in us and in whom we live is **magnified** in our bodies
- **Christ** expressed is **Christ magnified**.
 - No matter what the circumstances are, **Christ** be **magnified** in us.
 - We need to let others see **Christ** in the way of enlargement, in the way of magnification.
- **Christ** be **magnified** in us whether through **life** or through **death** (Phil. 1:20)
 - **Christ** is **magnified** in our living
 - **whether** through life or through death, **Christ** is magnified in our bodies.

✚ “... ‘I believed, therefore I spoke,’ we also **believe**, therefore we also **speak**,” (Psa. 116:10; 2Co 4:13)

✚ The **unlimited greatness** of **Christ**, is displayed in a way we express, exhibit, exalt, and extoll Him. We are a living witness of **Christ**, testifying of His ability, power, patience, love, and wisdom, all without measure. Wherever we are, we should express the greatness of **Christ** in an enlarged way. We **magnified** **Christ** both through **life** and through **death**.

✚ **As Christ lives** in us, is being **formed** in us, and makes His **home** in us, **spontaneously** we shall **live** Him. Then **Christ** will be **magnified** in us.

- ✓ We need to be those who live and **magnify** **Christ**.
- ✓ We need to live **Christ** day by day from morning to evening.
- ✓ We must live a life to show people **Christ**. **Christ** should be **magnified** in us by our living Him.
- ✓ We must show even the angels, the demons, and the evil spirits that we are a people who live **Christ** to **magnify** Him.

 All pleasures and **self-seeking**
 put away;
 Be Thou my **aim** [Psa. 73:25]
 and satisfaction solely, [John 6:35]
 Our loving union
 e'er through me convey.
- 4** Live through me, **Lord,** [Eph. 3:17]
 and make my heart Thy **dwelling,**
 Each chamber fully **occupied** by Thee;
 Thought, feeling, will, [Mark 12:30]
 infuse with Thee completely
 Till we've one **living out** unceasingly.
- 5** Live through me, **Lord;**
 stop **independent** action; [Rom. 12:4-5]
 Each breath, each step,
 would in Thy **Body** be.
Build us in Thee [Eph. 2:21-22]
 till we're Thy full **reflection,**
 Thy corporate one **new man** eternally.

- 1** Dear **Father God,** the sole **“I AM”**—
 Surely in heav'n [Exo. 3:14; Psa.105:1]
 Your name's **proclaimed!** [Duet 32:3]
 The **source** of all, and all that's real!
 In You alone are we sustained!
- 2** You are the only **One** who is! [1Tim.2:5]
 Nothing apart from You is real!
 If everything should cease to be,
 You would **exist forever** still. [1Tim.1:17]

Rev 4:11 –

You are **worthy,** our **Lord** and **God,** to
 receive the **glory** and the **honor** and the
 power, for You have **created all things,**
 and because of **Your will** they were, and
 were created.

Rom 1:20 –

For the **invisible** things of Him, both His
 eternal **power** and **divine** characteristics,
 have been **clearly seen** since the creation
 of the world, being **perceived** by the
 things made, so that they would be
 without excuse;
