Title	Element	Description
<b>The Spirit of God</b> Gen. 1:2	<b>Divinity</b>	In God's creation the Spirit of God was active. The element of the Spirit of God is God, divinity.
<b>The Spirit of Jehovah</b> Jdg. 3:10; 1 Sam. 10:6	<b>Divine Trinity</b>	Jehovah is a title used for God's contact with man. It denotes God's relationship with man. Only God is the One who is; He alone is the I Am. The Spirit of Jehovah is the extract of the element of the Triune God.
<b>The Holy Spirit</b> Luke 1:35; Matt. 1:20	<b>Holy divine nature</b>	"the Holy Spirit" was first used with respect to Christ's incarnation. Because the Lord Jesus was conceived of the Holy Spirit, He also is holy in nature.
<b>The Spirit of Reality</b> John 15:26		After the Lord's resurrection, His word concerning the Spirit as another Comforter, as the Spirit of reality, was fulfilled.
<b>The Spirit of Jesus</b> Acts 16:7	<b>Humanity, human living, and crucifixion</b>	The Spirit of Jesus has the elements of humanity, human living, and crucifixion.
<b>The Spirit of Christ</b> Rom. 8:9	<b>Resurrection</b>	The Spirit of Christ has the element of resurrection. This Spirit is the Spirit of God and also the Spirit of life.
<b>The Spirit of Jesus Christ</b> Phil. 1:19	<b>Bountiful supply of all the elements of humanity, human living, crucifixion, and resurrection</b>	Paul could rejoice in prison because he had the bountiful supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ. He enjoyed the Spirit of Jesus, the suffering One, and the Spirit of Christ, the resurrected One.
<b>The Spirit of Life</b> Rom. 8:2	<b>Riches of the divine life</b>	With the Spirit of life we have the riches of the divine life.
<b>The Life-Giving Spirit</b> 1 Cor. 15:45	<b>Impartation of the divine life</b>	The life-giving Spirit has the ability to give us life. Now we have life within us.
<b>The Lord Spirit</b> 2 Cor. 3:18	<b>Ascension and lordship</b>	In this aspect of the Spirit, the element of lordship is included.
<b>The Spirit of Grace</b> Heb. 10:29	<b>The enjoyment of the Triune God</b>	The Spirit of grace has the element of the enjoyment of the Triune God. This element is grace.
<b>The Seven Spirits</b> Rev. 1:4; 4:5; 5:6	<b>Sevenfold intensification</b>	The Spirit has the element of intensification.
<b>The Spirit - The All-Inclusive Spirit</b> John 7:37-39	<b>All the elements of the titles</b>	When all the aspects and elements of the Spirit are put together, we have a totality, an aggregate, known in the New Testament as the Spirit.
